2. Introduce no loading at any time restrictions on the following roads or lengths of road in Gravesham:

Gravesend Road, Higham (A226)


3. Introduce no waiting between 8am-9.30am or 2.30pm-4pm, Mon-Fri inclusive (single yellow lines) on the following roads or lengths of road in Gravesham:

Crutches Lane, Higham

The following items to be added to the Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

# GRAVESEND ROAD (A226), HIGHAM

# No Waiting at any time

On both sides from the junction with Telegraph Hill in a north westerly direction to a point 65 metres west of the junction with Crutches Lane

# No Loading at any time

- i) On the north west side from a point 31 metres north west of the junction with Telegraph Hill in a north westerly direction to a point 65 metres west of the junction with Crutches Lane
- ii) On the south east side from the junction with Telegraph Hill in a north westerly direction to a point 65 metres west of the junction with Crutches Lane

## FORGE LANE, HIGHAM

# No Waiting at any time

On both sides from the junction with Gravesend Road (A226) in a northerly direction to a point in line with the northern common boundary of house numbers 57 and 55.

#### CRUTCHES LANE, HIGHAM

#### No Waiting at any time

- (1) On the south eastern side from its junction with Gravesend Road (A226) to a point 21 metres south west of that junction
- (2) On the north western side from the junction with Gravesend Road (A226) to a point in line with the northern boundary of house number 1.

No Waiting between the hours of 8am - 9.30am and 2.30pm - 4pm, Monday to Friday inclusive

On the south eastern side from a point 21 metres south west of the junction with Gravesend Road (A226) to a point in line with the common boundary of house numbers 2 and 3.

This Order shall come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2012 and may be cited as The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Gravesham) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No 10) Order 2012.
