# THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF GRAVESHAM) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON THE FOOTWAY OR VERGE) ORDER 2010

The council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under section 9 and 10 of the Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Schedule 9 to the Act, HAS MADE the following Order:-

## PART A General

### Interpretation

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"The Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the Council" means the Kent County Council, as Traffic Authority;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle parked in contravention means the person driving the vehicle at the time of it being observed by the Civil Enforcement Officer.

"junction" means the junction of the marked, or if not so marked, the imaginary centre lines of the roads referred to and, where appropriate, measurements shall be taken from the point of intersection of the respective centre lines as projected.

"owner" in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used.

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a duly authorised officer able to carry out parking enforcement duties.

"road" means the full width of any length of Highway or of any other road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a road passes.

"restricted road" means the roads, lengths of road or sides of road (including any footway or verge and the perimeter of any central reservation, roundabout or traffic island) specified in the schedules to this Order.

The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under or having effect as if made under the Road traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

#### PART B

# Prohibition and restrictions on the waiting of vehicles Or the loading or unloading of vehicles

No person shall, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time with one or more wheels on any part of the footway or verge in the lengths of road specified in schedule one to this article. This article shall not apply:

- (i) to emergency services vehicles if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, or
- (ii) If any vehicle is required to stop by law;
- (iii) If any vehicle is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident;
- (iv) if any vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the driver's control.

Where any vehicle is stopping in contravention of any of the provisions contained within this Article and a Civil Enforcement Officer has reason to believe that a penalty charge is payable, he may:

- (i) fix a penalty charge to the vehicle, or
- (ii) give such a notice to the person appearing to him to be in charge of the vehicle.
