

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(ALBERT PLACE (A226), GRAVESEND))
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2010**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order was sealed on 31 January 2011, may be cited as the Kent County Council (Albert Place (A226), Gravesend))(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2010 and shall come into operation on the 7th day of February 2011.

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in any of the length of road set out in the Schedule to this Order.

EXEMPTIONS TO THE ORDER

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle gaining access for maintenance purposes and on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purposes for which it is being used on that occasion.

SCHEDULE

Roads to be closed to all motor vehicles at all times

Name of Road	Length of road affected
Albert Place	between the junction with Windmill Street and the junction with Wrotham Road.

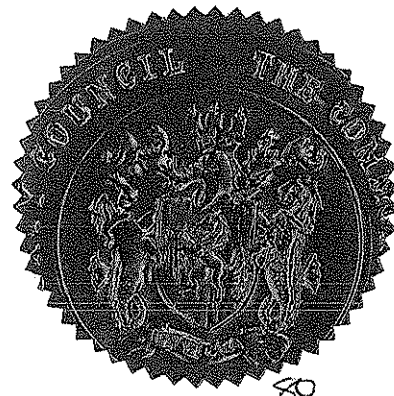
