

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(ST MARK'S AVENUE, NORTHFLEET)
(EXPERIMENTAL ONE WAY) ORDER 2011**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under Section 9 and 10 of the Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

COMMENCEMENT and CITATION

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of February 2011 and may be cited as the Kent County Council (St Mark's Avenue, Northfleet) (Experimental One Way) Order 2011.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall cause any vehicle to precede in a direction other than specified in the Schedule to this Order.

EXEMPTIONS FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from proceeding in a direction other than that specified in the Schedule referred to herein if it is:-
 - (i) a vehicle so required or authorised by a police constable in uniform.
 - (ii) being used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes;


