THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (CAISTER-ON-SEA, WINDSOR ROAD) (SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR CLEARWAY) ORDER, 2012

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of April 2012, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Caister-On-Sea, Windsor Road) (School Keep Clear Clearway) Order 2012.
- 2. In this Order:
 - "School Keep Clear" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1027.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- 3. Save as is provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of which the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait on Monday to Friday from 0800 hrs to 1700 hrs along the lengths of road specified as the School Keep Clear in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the length of road for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
 - (a) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (b) in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) any building operation or demolition;
 - (d) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road comprising or including that carriageway;

or

(f) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of road or side of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (g) a vehicle waiting on the main carriageway referred to in Article 3 while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access, or from which it has emerged, is opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than on that carriageway; or
- (h) a vehicle waiting when the person in control of the vehicle is required to stop by law, or is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstance outside their control.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
