THE BOROUGH OF HAVANT
(HAVANT BUS STATION SERVICE ROAD AND ACCESS TO
MERIDIAN SERVICE AREA, HAVANT) (PROHIBITION OF LOADING
AND UNLOADING) AND (SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2007

The Council of the Borough of Havant hereby gives notice that pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Hampshire in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2) and 4 (2) and 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the *thirteenth* day of *March* 2007 and may be cited as "The Borough of Havant (Havant Bus Station Service Road and Access to Meridian Service Area, Havant) (Prohibition of Loading and Unloading) and (Speed Limit) Order 2007
2. Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait or be loaded or unloaded in the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order if:
 - (a) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority, the Environment Agency or a water or sewerage undertaker within the meaning of the Water Act 1989 in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (b) to enable a vehicle of (and bearing a livery used by) a universal service provider within the meaning ascribed by the Postal Services Act 2000 to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the course of the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Act;

- (c) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (d) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade ambulance or police purposes.
5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

FIRST SCHEDULE
(Waiting, loading and unloading prohibited at all times)

Length of road in Havant

Bus Station Service Road

- a) from the inside of the service road at its eastern junction with Elm Lane to its western junction with Elm Lane
- b) from the outside of the service road, including the access to the Meridian service area, at its eastern junction with Elm Lane, southwards, westwards and northwards to a point 19 metres south of its western junction with Elm Lane
- c) the outside of the service road, from its junction with Elm Lane, southwards for a distance of 6 metres.

SECOND SCHEDULE
(20 mph Speed Limit)

Length of road in Havant

Bus Station Service Road

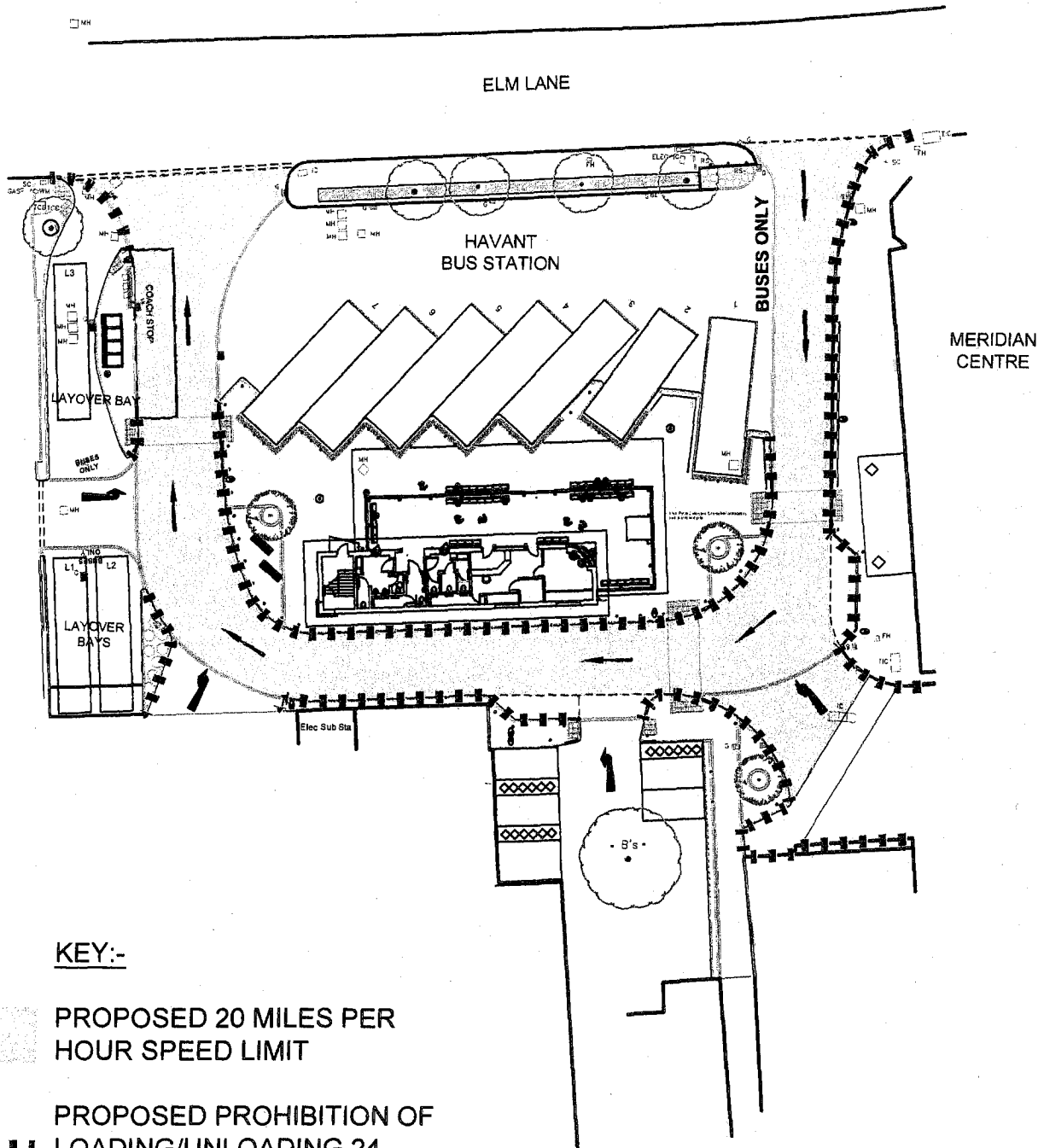
