THE BOROUGH OF HAVANT (BRIGHTSIDE, LABURNUM ROAD, MILL ROAD AND REGENCY GARDENS, WATERLOOVILLE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2007

The Council of the Borough of Havant hereby gives notice that pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Hampshire in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the twentieth day of April 2007 and may be cited as "The Borough of Havant (Brightside, Laburnum Road, Mill Road and Regency Gardens, Waterlooville) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2007".
- 2. The part of Order specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. (1) In this Order -

"authorised hackney carriage stand" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with Diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 to The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"authorised parking place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 as amended;

"hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 38(1) of the Vehicles Excise and Registration Act 1994;

"Parking Attendant" means a person authorised by the Council to enforce the restrictions imposed by this Order;

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge or a parking disc in the relevant position when and only when they are displayed in

- (f) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
- (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule at any time on any day.
- (3) Nothing in Article 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle -
 - (a) to wait upon an authorised parking place or
 - (b) being a hackney carriage to wait upon an authorised hackney carriage stand.
- (4) Nothing in Article 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of roads referred to in the Second Schedule for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day).
- 6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

EXTENT OF REVOCATION

Schedule No.4 (no waiting at any Time), Paragraph 4.389 - Both Sides of Mill Road, between its Junction with A3 London Road and a Point 10 metres south-east of that Junction.

SECOND SCHEDULE (Waiting prohibited at all times)

Lengths of roads in Waterlooville

Brightside

- a) North-west side:-
 - from its junction with Mill Road, south-westwards for a distance of 22 metres
- b) South-east side:-
 - i) from its junction with Mill Road, south-westwards for a distance of 23 metres

Laburnum Road

- a) North-west side:-
 - from its junction with Mill Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 10 metres
- b) South-east side:-
 - from its junction with Mill Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 10 metres

Mill Road

- a) North-east side
 - i) from its junction with London Road/A3, south-eastwards to a point 15 metres southeast of the centreline of Laburnum Road
- b) South-west side
 - from its junction with London Road/A3, south-eastwards to a point 18 metres south-east of the centreline of Brightside

Regency Gardens

- a) North-west side:-
 - from its junction with Mill Road north-eastwards for a distance of 18 metres
- b) South-east side:
 - i) from its junction with Mill Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 21 metres
