(iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road:

- (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said sides of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or telecommunication;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of road;
 - (e) to enable a public service vehicle being used in the operation of a local service to wait at an authorised stopping place for the purpose of –
 - (i) allowing a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to pay a fare;
 - (ii) the vehicle to wait, if it arrives at the stopping place in advance of the advertised time for a period not exceeding 15 minutes.
 - (f) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said sides of road for so long as is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (g) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes.
4. Nothing in article 2 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any side of road referred to in that article if that vehicle is a hackney carriage waiting at an authorised hackney carriage stand. Article 3 of this order will not apply in respect of any part of any side of road designated as an authorised hackney carriage stand.
5. In the event of any dispute as to the meaning of any heading used in any part of this order or any schedule to this order, the substantive wording in the order or schedule shall prevail over the heading. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

PART III - REVOCATION

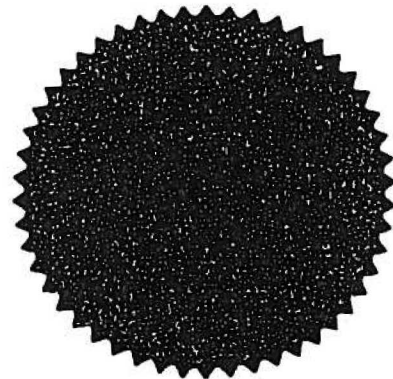
6. The order specified in column 1 of schedule II to this order is hereby revoked to the extent specified in column 2 of that schedule.

7. This order shall come into operation on the 8th October 2007 and may be cited as "The Hampshire (A3 London Road, Waterloooville) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Unloading) Order 2007".
