

THE BOROUGH OF HAVANT
(HAVANT: SOUTHBROOK CLOSE AND SOUTHBROOK ROAD) (EXPERIMENTAL
RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (NO 3) ORDER 2010

The Council of the Borough of Havant ("the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with the County Council of Hampshire in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-


1. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-first day of October 2010 and may be cited as "The Borough of Havant (Havant: Southbrook Close and Southbrook Road) (Experimental Restriction Of Waiting) Order 2010."
2. This Order will cease to have effect after the twenty-eighth day of February 2011.
3. The Solicitor to the Council may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision contained in it in accordance with Section 10 of the Act.
4. (1) In this Order -
 - "**delivering**" and "**collecting**" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
 - "**disabled person's badge**" or "**blue badge**" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 SI 682;
 - "**disabled person's vehicle**" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 as amended;
 - "**loading**" means the loading or unloading of goods to or from a vehicle;
- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge or a parking disc in the relevant position when and only when they are displayed in accordance with Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
- (3) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
5. Save as provided in Article 6 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
6. (1) Subject to the provisions in Article 7 nothing in Article 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -

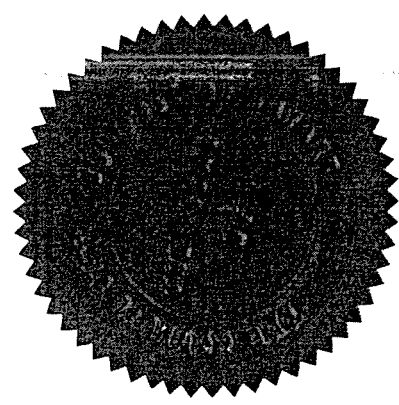
- 7. Those vehicles described in Article 6 (1) (a) to (h) are subject to the provision that:-
 - (a) there is no reasonable alternative place to stop or wait; and
 - (b) they only stop and wait for so long as is necessary.
- 8. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

Lengths of roads in Havant

Southbrook Close	east side:- from its junction with Southbrook Road, northwards for a distance of 19 metres. west side:- from its junction with Southbrook Road, northwards for a distance of 11 metres. north side:- from a point 41 metres east of its junction with Langstone Road, eastwards, to a point 16 metres east of its junction with Southbrook Close, measured from the centreline.
