ROAD TRAFFIC RECULATION ACT 1967

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

(ST. JOHN STREET, HEREFORD)

(PRCHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1972

The Chunty Council of Hereford and Worcester, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so smended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") said Act of 1967 as so smended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Folice in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- The City of Hereford (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1974 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though item 25 of Schedule 5 and item 10 of Schedule 8 to the Order shall be deleted therefrom.
- Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a treffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the whole of the east side and on that length of the west wait on the whole of the cast side and on that length of the west side of St. John Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Bide of St. John Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from its junction with Cathedral Close northwards to a point 43.9 metres (144 feet) south of its junction with East Street.
- Save as provided in Articles 4 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00a.m. and 6.30p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the west side of St. John Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester from it's junction with East Street to a point 43.9 metres(144 feet) south of that junction:
 - (a) for a longer period than one hour; or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting of the vehicle in the said side of length of road.
 - Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the sides of lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection

with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of lengths of roul referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said sides of lengths of road of any sever or of any drain, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;

- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently he used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postel packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Lat, 1953;
- (f) for the purpose of removing furniture and offects from one office or dwelling house to another or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
- (g) for the taking by any vehicle of oil, petrol, water or air from any garage situate on or adjacent to the said sides of lengths of road;
- 5. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the sides of lengths of road referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same side of length of road on the same day).
- The restrictions imposed by Article 3 of this Order shall not apply to a disabled person's vehicle left by the driver thereof being a vehicle which displays in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Eremptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Vales) Regulations 1971, as amended, a badge issued under the Disabled Persons (Badge for Notor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, in pursuance of a scheme under Section 2) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act, 1970

7. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975; "parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (ES No. 4631: 1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hours period during which a period of waiting bogins; and

"relevant position" means:-

- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the disabled person's badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; and
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.
- 8. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of February 1979 and may be cited as the County of Hereford and Morcester (St. John Street, Hereford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Order 1979.
