(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1978

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as unended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the local emended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter reformed to as "the Act of 1967") and of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter reformed to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 and 3, no person shall except upon the directs of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or a traffic warder, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the north side of St. Owens Street, Heroford in the County of Heroford and Worcester from a point 8.2 metres (27 feet) west of its junction with Turner Street, for a distance of 31.7 metres (117 feet) in a westerly direction and for a point 9.1 metres (30 feet) east of its junction with Turner Street from a point 9.1 metres (30 feet) east of its junction with Turner Street for a distance of 23.8 metres (78 feet) in an easterly direction.
 - 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the sides of lengths of read referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded and unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of lengths of road referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or lengths of road of any sever repair is or near to the said sides of lengths of road of any sever or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph line as defined in the Tolegraph Act of the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph line as defined in the Tolegraph Act of
 - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other read, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting population as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of removing furniture and effective one office or dwellinghouse to another or to such precises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
 - (g) the vehicle to take in oil, petrol, water or air free any garage situate on or adjacent to the sidesof lengthsof road.

- (h) the vehicle to wait at or mean to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said sides of lengths of rend for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
- (i) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to a disabled person's vehicle left by the driver thereof being a vehicle which displays in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions in accordance with the Local Authorities Regulations 1971, as amended for Disabled Persons) (England and Walea) Regulations 1971, as amended a badge issued under the Disabled Persons (Badge for Motor Vehicles) a badge issued under the Disabled Persons (Badge for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, in parausance of a scheme under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act. 1970.
 - 4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th August 1978 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (St. Owen's Street Hereford) (Prohibition of Woiting) Order 1978.
