ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

(ST. OWEN STREET, OFFA STREET, ST. PETER'S STREET  
AND COMMERCIAL STREET, HEREFORD)

(STREET PARKING PLACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS VEHICLES) ORDER 1987

Hereford and Worcester County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf and with the consent of every authority and person responsible for the maintenance of the roads affected by the Order and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby making the following Order:-

1. (1) Each of the parts of roads specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles as in such positions are specified in relation to that part of road in the said Schedule;  
(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstructions of the streets, by order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or where the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking space.
2. Where in the Schedule to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver shall not permit the vehicle to wait in that parking place:-
  - (a) unless it is of the specified class; or
  - (b) in a position other than that specified.
3. A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place:-
  - (a) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the roads or the use of the roads by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
  - (b) when for preventing obstruction of the streets the Council shall by order made on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing illumination or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed have closed that parking place and exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place.

4. In this Order:-


"parking place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.

"disabled persons vehicle" means vehicle which displays in accordance with the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986, a badge issued under the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of November 1987 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (St Owen Street, Offa Street, St. Peter's Street and Commercial Street, Hereford) (Street Parking Places for Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1987
