(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997

Hereford and Worcester County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 as so amended, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Springfield Avenue, Hereford in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester from its junction with Belmont Avenue to its junction with Hunderton Avenue, in a direction other than north east to south west.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any road cleansing vehicle.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of February 1997 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Springfield Avenue, Hereford) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1997.

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (SPRINGFIELD AVENUE, HEREFORD) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1997
