THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (PLOUGH LANE AND HARROW ROAD, HEREFORD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1979

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) (and &4D(1)) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967"), and of all other powers them enabling on that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:

 This Order shall come into operation on the 5rd day of December 1979 and may be cited as the County of Hereford and Worcester (Plough Lane and Harrow Road, Hereford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979.

2. . (1) In this Order:

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631: 1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:
 - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when:
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
 - (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- (3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

- 3. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the road and sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedulesto this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on that length of the west side of Plough Lair the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Wordester which extends from a point 32 metres (105 feet) north of its junction with Whitecross Road, for a distance of 46.5 metres (153 feet) in a northerly direction.
- 5. (1) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall render it unlawful unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road and sides of lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in Connection with any of the following operations, namely: (i
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (45) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road and sides of lengths of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said length of road and sides of lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conviniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1955;
 - (e) the vehicle to take in petrol, cil, water or air from any garage situate on or

- (f) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road and sides of lengths of road for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
- (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (h) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle at any time on any day.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the length of road and sides of lengths of road referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road and sides of lengths of road on the same day).
- 6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.



FIRST SCHEDULE

A length of road and sides of lengths of road in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester on which parking of vehicles is prohibited at all times

1. Harrow Lane

That length which extends from its junction with Plough Lane for a distance of 50 meteres (164 feet) in a westerly direction.

2. Plough Lane

West side; from its junction with Whitecross Road for a distance of 32 metros (105 feet) in a northerly direction.

3. Plough Lane

East side; from a point 78.5 metros (258 feet) north of its junction with Whitecross Road for a distance of 255 metres (837 feet) in a northerly direction.

4. Plough Lane

East side; from its junction with Whitecross Road for a distance of 333.5 metres (1094 feet) in a portherly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

A side of length of road in the City of Hereford in the County of Ecreford and Worcester on which parking of vehicles is prohibited between the hours of 5.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Kondays to Saturdays inclusive

1. Plough Lane

West side; from a point 32 metres (105 feet) north of its junction with whitecross Road for a distance of 46.5 metres (153 feet) in a northerl; direction.
