(Bewell Street, Hereford)

(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982

NOTICE is hereby given that on 28th October 1982 the County Council of Hereford and Worcester made an Order under Section 1(1), (2), (3) & 8(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 18 of the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is:-

- (1) to prohibit waiting at any time on the sides of lengths of road in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the First Schedule to this Notice.
- (2) to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8.00a.m. and 5.30p.m. on any day on that side of length of Bewell Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Second Schedule to this Notice.

The Order will come into operation on 2th November 1982.

A copy of the Order so made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that Section or of Section 8(1), 8(2) or 8(3) of the Act of 1967 or of any regulations made under the said Section 8(2) has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this Notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

(a) South side

~~from a point 23 metres (75 ft) east of its junction with All Saints Street to its junction with Widenash Street.~~

(b) North side

from its junction with Widenash Street to its junction with Victoria Street.

Side or length of Sewell Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester.

South side

from a point 23 metres (75 ft) east of its junction with Victoria Street to a point 23 metres (75 ft) east of its junction with All Saints Street.

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

(BEWELL STREET, HEREFORD)

(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1982

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester, in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2), (3) and 34D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1973 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1967') and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 34C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The City of Hereford (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1974 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though the following were deleted therefrom:-
  - Item 9(a) of Schedule 2
  - Item 1(a) of Schedule 3
  - Item 1 of Schedule 11
2. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on those sides or lengths of Bewell Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
3. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. - 6.30 p.m. on any day on that side of length of Bewell Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides or lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto and unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operations or demolition, the removal or replacement

struction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of lengths of road referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;

- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (e) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (f) for the purpose of removing furniture and effects from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
  - (g) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (h) the vehicle is to be used in connection with any wedding or funeral service.
5. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the sides of lengths of road referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same sides of length of road on the same day).

6. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons' (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631 : 1970) but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -

- (1) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the rear side or immediately behind the windscreen; and

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or rear side of the vehicle;

(b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.

7. This Order shall come into operation on the 6th day of November 1982 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Bewell Street, Hereford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982.
