ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

(BROAD STREET AND WIDEMARSH STREET, HEREFORD)

(PARKING PLACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS VEHICLES) ORDER 1993

Hereford and Worcester County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32(1) and 35(1) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of every authority and person responsible for the maintenance of the roads affected by the Order and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby making the following Order:-

1. (a) The City of Hereford (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1974 is hereby varied and shall have the effect as follows:-
 - ✓(i) part 4 of item 13 of Schedule 2 thereof relating to Broad Street was amended to read:-

"from a point 7 metres (23 feet) south of its junction with West Street to its junction with High Street."
 - ✓(ii) part 6 of item 13 of Schedule 2 thereof relating to the east side of Broad Street was amended to read:-

"the east side, from a point 12 yards south of its junction with East Street to a point 7 metres (23 feet) north of its junction with East Street."
 - ✓(iii) item 38 of Schedule 2 thereof relating to Widemarsh Street was deleted therefrom.
 - ✓(iv) item 1(a) of Schedule 14 thereof, relating to the west side of Broad Street was amended to read:-

"(a) the west side, from a point 13 metres (42 feet) south of its junction with West Street for a distance of 22 metres (72 feet) in a southerly direction".
 - ✓(v) item 1(d) of Schedule 14 thereof, relating to the east side of Broad Street was amended to read:-

"(d) from a point 21.5 yards north of its junction with East Street for a distance of 9.5 yards in a northerly direction".
- ✓(b) The County of Hereford and Worcester (Widemarsh Street, Hereford) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1983 is hereby revoked.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of streets, by order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or where the streets are intended or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking space.

3. Where in the Schedule to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver shall not permit the vehicle to wait in that parking place:

- (a) unless it is of the specified class; or
- (b) in a position other than that specified.

4. Nothing in Article 3 hereto shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any parking place for so long as may be necessary to enable:

- (a) the vehicle to be used in connection with any of the following operation, namely:
 - (i) building or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to any parking place of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (b) the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 67 of the Post Office Act 1959;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

5. A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place:-

- (e) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the roads or the use of the roads by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
- (f) when for preventing obstruction of the streets the Council shall by order made on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are intended or liable to be obstructed have closed that parking place and exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place.

6. In this Order:

"parking place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.

7 This Order shall come into operation on the 11th day of May 1993 and may be cited as the County of Hereford and Worcester (Broad Street and Widemarsh Street, Hereford) (Parking Places for Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1993



THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (BROAD STREET AND WIDEMARSH STREET,
HEREFORD) VARIOUS ORDERS 1993

On 29th April 1993 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will-

- (a) establish a total of four disabled persons parking places in three locations in Broad Street and Widemarsh Street, Hereford;
- (b) establish a daytime loading/unloading area on Widemarsh Street, Hereford operating between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. The length of stay will not exceed 30 minutes (returning prohibited within 2 hours). Between 6.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m. the area will be reserved for Hackney Carriages. The Order will come into operation on 11th May 1993.

The Order contains exemptions to allow parking for certain purposes

A copy of the Order, relevant map, Statement of Reasons for making the Order and affected existing regulations may be inspected at County Hall, Spon Street, Worcester, WR1 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 10th June 1993.
