

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**COUNTY OF HEREFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL**

**(GAOL STREET, HEREFORD)**  
**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING)**  
**(DISABLED PARKING BAYS) ORDER 2001**

The County of Herefordshire District Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 2001 and may be cited as The County of Herefordshire District Council Gaol Street, Hereford (Prohibition of Waiting) (Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Parking Bays) Order 2001.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the City of Hereford (Various Street) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1974 and the County of Hereford and Worcester (Union Street, St. Peters Square and Gaol Street, Hereford) (Parking Places for Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1994 are hereby varied to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Order.
3. (1) In this Order:-  
  
"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;  
  
"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;  
  
"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured blue if issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2000 or orange if issued before that date, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.  
  
(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
  - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when:-
    - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; and
    - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

- (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when:-
    - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; and
    - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
4. Save as provided in Articles 8 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on those lengths of road and on those days and between those times mentioned in Schedule One to this Order and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
  5. Save as provided in sub-sections (a) to (f) of Article 8 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload on those lengths of road and on those days and between those times mentioned in Schedule Two to this Order and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
  6. Save as provided in Articles 8 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait longer than one hour (no return within 2 hours) on the length of road and on those days and between those times mentioned in Schedule Three to this Order and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
  7. Save as provided in Article 8 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than a disabled persons vehicles which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the disabled parking bays/parking places on those days and between those times mentioned in Schedule Four to this Order and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
  8. Nothing in Articles 4, 5, 6 and 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the sides of those lengths of road referred to in the Schedules herein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
    - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
    - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of those lengths of road referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of those lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;



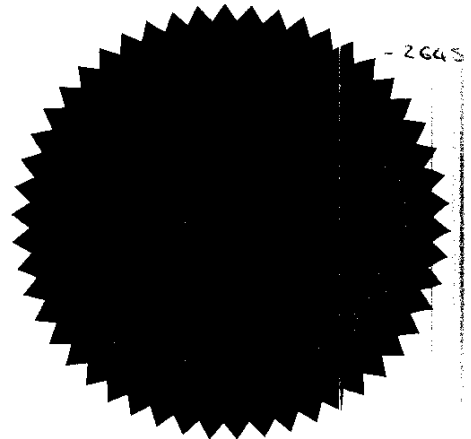
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of any statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of removing furniture and effects from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
- (f) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.
- (g) For the loading and unloading of a vehicle.

- 9. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the said sides of those lengths of road referred to in Schedule One hereto for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same sides of length of road on the same day).
- 10. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the said sides of those lengths of road referred to in Schedule 2 hereto without limitation.
- 11. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
- 12. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.
