

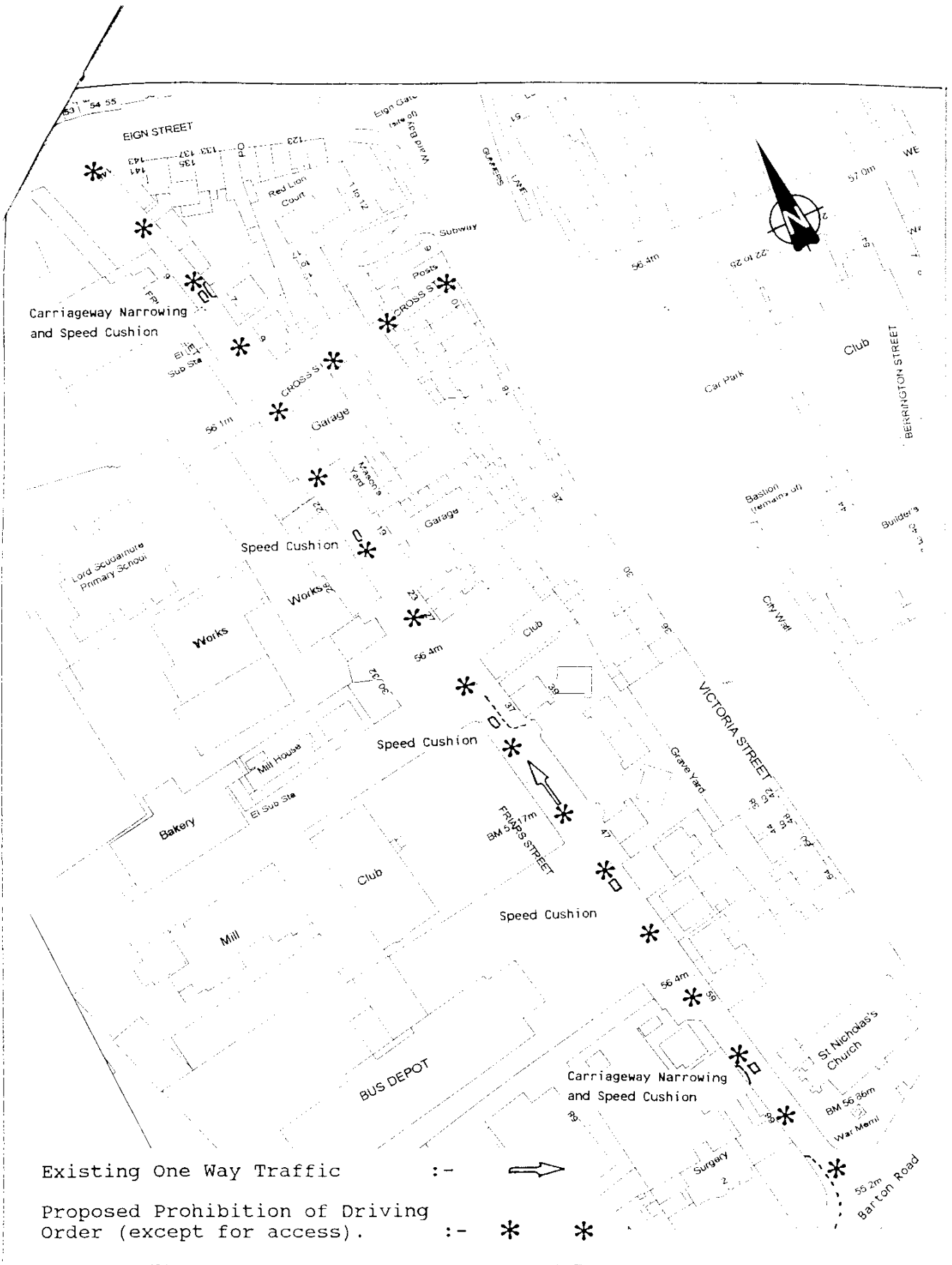

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER**  
**(FRIARS STREET AND CROSS STREET, HEREFORD)**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1996**

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait on the lengths of roads in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The restrictions imposed by Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to the following vehicles:-
  - (a) vehicles when being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (b) vehicles, if they cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, when being used in connection with any building operation or demolition the removal of any obstruction to traffic the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (c) vehicles, if they cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, when being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) mechanical road cleansing vehicles;
  - (e) vehicles requiring access to premises or land fronting the said lengths of roads to which there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access;
  - (f) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th day of September 1996 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Friars Street and Cross Street, Hereford) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1996.
