ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

(CHURCH STREET, HEREFORD) (PROHIBITION OF
DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 1979

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-


1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed or wait in the road known as Church Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed or wait in the said road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) for the police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or re-construction of the road referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
 - (c) to enable the cleansing of the road to be undertaken;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road provided the vehicle does not wait in the road for any period exceeding thirty minutes, not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road on the same day.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to a disabled person's vehicle being a vehicle which displays in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1971, as amended, a badge issued under the Disabled Persons (Badge for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, in pursuance of a scheme

under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970, provided that such disabled persons vehicle shall not wait for any period exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road on the same day).

4. The Council are satisfied that for the avoidance of danger or the prevention of the likelihood of danger arising to persons or other traffic using the road to which this Order relates it is requisite that Section 1(5) of the 1967 Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the twelfth day of February 1979 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Church Street, Hereford) (Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 1979.
