

# **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

#### (MILL STREET, HEREFORD)

## (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING)

**ORDER 1995** 

24th April 1995.

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload at any time on the sides of lengths of Mill Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified 1. in the Schedule to this Order.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the sides of lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long 2. as may be necessary to enable:
  - a person to board or alight from the vehicle; (a)
  - the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the sides of lengths of road referred to, or the laying, (b) erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
    - the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; (c)
    - the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953; (d)
    - the vehicle to be used for the purpose of removing furniture and effects from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the police, their consent is obtained and (e) such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
    - the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes. (f)
  - The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is 3. without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
  - This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of April 1995 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (Mill Street, Hereford) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Loading and Unloading) Order 1995. 4.

### THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (MILL STREET, HEREFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 1995

On 13th April 1995 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will prohibit waiting, loading and unloading at any time on the following lengths of Mill Street,

- 1. south west side, from the end of the turning area for a distance of 8 metres in a south easterly direction; and from a point 13 metres south east of the turning area for a distance of 2 metres in a south easterly direction; 2.
- north west side, from the end of the turning area for a distance of 5 metres in a
- turning area, for its entire length, a total distance of 5.8 metres. 3.

The Order will come into operation on 24th April 1995.

The Order contains exemptions to allow parking for certain purposes.

A copy of the Order, relevant map and Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 1st June 1995.

Sides of lengths of Mill Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester.

1.	south west side	-	from the end of the turning area for a distance of 8 metres in a south easterly direction;
		-	from a point 13 metres south east of the turning area for a distance of 2 metres in a south easterly direction;
2.	north west side	-	from the end of the turning

2. north west side - from the end of the turning area for a distance of 5 metres in a north easterly direction;

3. turning area - for its entire length, a total distance of 5.8 metres.
