CITY OF HEREFORD (OFFA STREET) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC
AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1970

The Hereford City Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

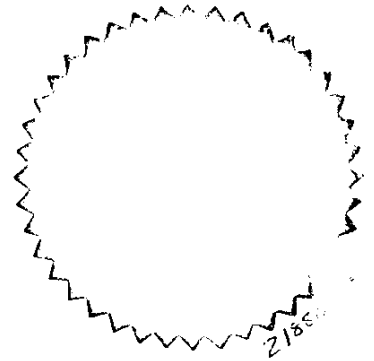
1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in the road specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length and side of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle when being used between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 7.00 a.m.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length and side of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length and side of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length and side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
 - (e) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or prohibitions imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid or by any by-law or agreement.

6. The Traffic Orders referred to in the Third Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked in so far as they affect the road specified in the said First Schedule to this Order and the length and side of road specified in the said Second Schedule to this Order
7. This Order shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of December 1970 and may be cited as the City of Hereford (Offa Street) (One-Way Traffic and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970.
