

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

(WIDEMARSH STREET, HEREFORD)

(BUS STOP) (CLEARWAY) (NO. 2) ORDER 1988

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them respectively, that is to say:-

"the Traffic Signs Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981;

"prohibited area" in relation to the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto, means all those areas of carriageway of the road bounded by the outer line of a road marking shown in Diagram 1025.1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and for the time being lawfully in place, and along which area is placed a road marking in the form of a yellow line near to the edge of the carriageway;

"stage carriage" means a stage carriage as defined in Section 2 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

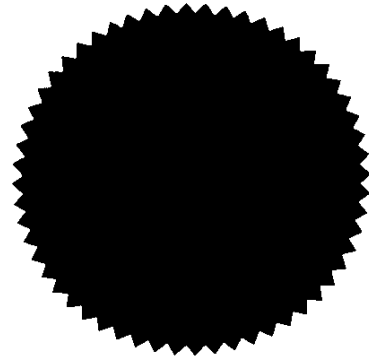
"express carriage" means an express carriage as defined in Section 2 of the said Act of 1981;

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a stage carriage or an express carriage to wait between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on any day in any prohibited area in that length of the east side of Widemarsh Street in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from its junction with Blueschool Street to its junction with Maylord Street.
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any prohibited area if the vehicle:-
 - (a) is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or

- (b) is being used in the service of the Council or with the permission of the Council and whilst being so used in such service it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the place where it is waiting; or
 - (c) is being used in the exercise of statutory powers or duties; or
 - (d) is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; or
 - (e) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop, or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident, or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.
4. The Council are satisfied that for facilitating the passage of vehicular traffic on the sides of lengths of roads to which this Order relates, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act of 1984 should not apply in relation to this Order.
 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of April 1988 and may be cited as the County of Hereford and Worcester (Widemarsh Street, Hereford) (Bus Stop) (Clearway) (No. 2) Order 1988
