

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Herefordshire County Council (Millpond Street and  
Greenpits Road, Ross on Wye) (Prohibition of Waiting)  
Order, 1974.

The Herefordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. Save as provided in article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
3. Nothing in Article 1 or in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the road, on the side of road or in any of the lengths of road referred to in these Articles, as the case may be, for so long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, of the side of road or of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road, the said side of road or any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
  - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
  - (e) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any source situated on or adjacent to the said road, the said side of road or any of the said lengths of road.

4. The Interpretation Act 1839 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an act of Parliament.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the ~~first~~ day of ~~May~~ 1974, and may be cited as The Herefordshire County Council (Millpond Street and Greenpits Road, Ross on Wye) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1974.

SCHEDULE 1

Lengths of road in the Ross on Wye Urban District:

Hillpond Street, east side, from its junction with Overroes Road to its junction with Greenpits Road.

Greenpits Road, north side, from its junction with Hillpond Street to its junction with Station Approach.

SCHEDULE 2

Lengths of road in the Ross on Wye Urban District:

Ross on Wye/B01 Hillpond Street, west side, from its junction with Brookend Street to its junction with Station Street.

Greenpits Road, south side, from its junction with Station Street to its junction with Cantilupe Road.
