

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

## (NEW ROAD, BROMYARD)

## (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1978

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967"), and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the north-west side of New Road, Bromyard, in the District of Malvern Hills in the County of Hereford and Worcester from a point 108 m (355 ft.) south-west of its junction with High Street for a distance of 24 m (79 ft.) in a south-westerly direction;
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the side of length of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded and unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of length of road referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said side of length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
  - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (e) for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (f) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said side or any of the said lengths of road for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
  - (g) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 3. The restriction imposed by Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a disabled person's vehicle left by the driver thereof being a vehicle which displays in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Fersons)(England and Wales)Regulations 1971, as amended, a badge issued under the Disabled Persons(Badge for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, in pursuance of a scheme under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Fersons Act, 1970.

- 4. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th January 1978 1978 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (New Road, Bromyard) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978.
