**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER**  
**(A449 NEW STREET, LEDBURY)**

**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1987 (VARIATION) ORDER 1994**

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The County of Hereford and Worcester (A449 New Street, Ledbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though Article 1 thereof was amended to read:-
  - "1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the south side of New Street in the Town of Ledbury in the District of Malvern Hills in the County of Hereford and Worcester from a point 122 metres west of its junction with A417 at Upper Cross for a distance of 158 metres in a westerly direction."
2. The Order shall come into operation on the 8th day of March 1994 and may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (A449 New Street, Ledbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987 (Variation) Order 1994.

**THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (A449 NEW STREET, LEDBURY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1987 (VARIATION) ORDER 1994**

On 24th February 1994 Hereford and Worcester County Council made an Order which will extend the existing prohibition of waiting at any time on the south side of New Street, Ledbury for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction from its existing terminal point 250 metres west of its junction with A417 at Upper Cross. The Order will come into operation on 8th March 1994.

The Order contains exemptions to allow parking for certain purposes and limited waiting by disabled persons vehicles.

A copy of the Order, relevant map, Statement of Reasons for making the Order and affected existing regulations may be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, WR5 2NP during normal office hours.

The validity of the Council's powers in making the Order or this exercise of them may be questioned by application to the High Court by 7th April 1994.
