## (KING STREET, HEREFORD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2004

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), the Road Traffic Act 1991 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November 2004 and may be cited as The County of Herefordshire District Council (King Street, Hereford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2004.
- 2. On the date this Order comes into operation as stated above Schedule 5 item 19 and Schedule 11 item 3 of the City of Hereford (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1974 will be revoked and the County of Hereford & Worcester (King Street, Hereford) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1983 will be revoked and any reference to King Street in the Schedule to the County of Hereford & Worcester (Broad Street, West Street and King Street, Hereford) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1997 will be revoked.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 6 (a) (c) (d) (f) and (g) of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Parking Attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or to load and unload at any time along the various lengths of road listed in Schedule 1.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 6 and 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Parking Attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait longer than 1 hour (no return within 2 hours) Monday to Saturday 8 am to 6.30 pm along the various lengths of road listed in Schedule 2.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Parking Attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait longer than 15 minutes (no return within 1 hour) in order to load or unload Monday to Saturday 8 am to 6.30 pm along the various lengths of road listed in Schedule 3.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 3 4 or 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the sides of those lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded onto and/or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of those lengths of road referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said sides of those lengths of road of any sewer or of any


main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets.
- (f) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of removing furniture and effects from one office or dwellinghouse to another, or to such premises from a depository or from such premises to a depository, provided notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the Police and Parking Authority, their consent is obtained and such reasonable conditions as they may impose are complied with;
- (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.
- 7. Nothing in Articles 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge, and a Parking Disc (on which the Driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the said sides of those lengths of road referred to in Schedule 2 hereto without limitation.
- 8. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
- 9. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

## U80000 King Street

## South Side

- from its junction with Palace Yard to a point 9.4 metres west of its junction with the eastern kerbline of U80000 Broad Street.
- from a point 32.4 metres west of its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to its junction with U82345 Bridge Street.

## North Side

- from a point 34.0 metres east of its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to its junction with the western kerbline of U80000 Broad Street.
- from its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to a point 16.0 metres east of that junction.
  - From its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to a point 11.1 metres west of that junction.
  - From a point 33.0 metres west of its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to its junction with U80000 St. Nicholas Street.

### SCHEDULE 2

## WAITING LIMITED TO 1 HOUR - (NO RETURN WITHIN 2 HOURS) - MONDAY TO SATURDAY 8 AM TO 6.30 PM

#### U80000 King Street

## South Side

from a point 25.5 metres west of its junction with the eastern kerbline of U80000 Broad Street to a point 18.0 metres west of its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street.

### North Side

- from a point 16.0 metres east of its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to a point 34.0 metres east of that junction.
  - From a point 11.1 metres west of its junction with the centre line of the U80002 Aubrey Street to a point 33.0 metres west of that junction.

## SCHEDULE 3

# LOADING ONLY LIMITED TO 15 MINUTES (NO RETURN WITHIN 1 HOUR) MONDAY TO SATURDAY 8 AM TO 6.30 PM INCLUDING

## U80000 King Street

## South Side

- from a point 9.4 metres west of its junction with the eastern kerbline of U80000 Broad Street to a point 25.5 metres west of that junction.
  - from a point 18.0 metres west of its junction with the centre line of U80002 Aubrey Street to a point 32.4 metres west of that junction.
