ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF HERTSMERE (Radlett Controlled Parking Zone) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2007

Hertsmere Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of The Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Hertfordshire County Council ("the County Council") and in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1-4, 32 and 35, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986) and Section 43 and Schedule 3 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act has made the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 August 2007 and may be cited as "The Borough of Hertsmere (Radlett Controlled Parking Zone) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2007" hereinafter referred to as "this Order".
- 2. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order:

The Borough of Hertsmere (Control of Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2007.

- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into effect of this Order, The Borough of Hertsmere (Control of Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2007 (hereinafter called "the 2007 Order") shall have effect so as to substitute items in the Schedule to this Order for corresponding items in Schedule 2 of the 2007 Order.
- 5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by any other enactment.
