

**The Hertsmere Borough Council
(Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.1) Order 2007**

Coming into operation: 6 August 2007


Hertsmere Borough Council in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33 and 35 and Part IV to Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and sections 43 and schedule 3 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of Hertfordshire County Council and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 August 2007 and may be cited as The Hertsmere Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2007.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done to or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into effect of this Order, the Hertsmere Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2005 (hereinafter called "the 2005 Order") shall have effect with:
 - a) The Schedule to this Order substituted for Schedule 3 to the 2005 Order; and
 - b) The expressions "penalty charge" (which with the expression "penalty charge notice" is to have the meaning ascribed to it by Section 66 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 as applied to Hertsmere Borough Council and its area) substituted for the expression "special charge" wherever that expression appears in the 2005 Order.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

To amend the current car parking charges in the Council's car parks in Borehamwood, Potters Bar and Radlett in order to ensure that decriminalisation becomes self-financing as soon as possible in accordance with Government advice.

To improve car-parking management, encourage increased use of the car parks by local workers and commuters and to discourage long-stay parking by local workers and commuters in residential streets close to the main line railway stations.
