### THE ISLE OF WIGHT COUNCIL (PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION ORDER) ORDER NO 3 2023

The Isle of Wight Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), the Road Traffic Act 1991 (the Act of 1991") as amended by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and under Section 13 of the Isle of Wight Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

### Citation and commencement

- 1. This Order shall come into operation at 0001 hours on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023 and may be cited as the Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) (Consolidation Order) No 3 2023.
- 2. Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) (Consolidation Order) No 3 2023 Plans (the "Plans") are incorporated into this Order.

### Revocation and Consolidation

- 3. a) The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No. 2 2020 is hereby revoked.
  - b) The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No 1 2022, is hereby consolidated
  - c) The Isle of Wight Council (Esplanade, Ventnor) (Parking Places) Order No 1 2022, is hereby consolidated,
  - d) The Isle of Wight Council (Esplanade, Ryde) (Parking Places) Order No 1 2023, is hereby <u>consolidated</u>,
  - e) The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No 1 2019 Notice of Variation No 1 2020, is hereby consolidated,
  - f) The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No 1 2020 Notice of Variation No 1 2022, is hereby consolidated,
  - g) The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No 2 2020 Notice of Variation No 2 2022, is hereby consolidated,
  - h) The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No 2 2020 & The Isle of Wight Council (Parking Places) Order No 1 2022 Notice of Variation No 1 2023, is hereby consolidated.

### Interpretation

- 4. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:
  - "animal" has the same meaning as Sections 86 and 89 of the Animal Health 1981.
  - "Council" means the Isle of Wight Council.

"disabled persons badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.

"driver" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984.

"heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Act of 1984.

"invalid carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 136(5) of the Act of 1984.

"Isle of Wight Car Club permit holder" means a person to whom an Isle of Wight Car Club parking permit has been issued for use in specific "Car Club" marked bays within the relevant Car Parks under the provisions of this Order.

"motor car" has the same meaning as in Section 136(2) of the Act of 1984.

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136(4) of the Act of 1984.

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136(1) of the Act of 1984.

"owner" in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used. In determining who was the owner at any time it shall be presumed that the owner was the person named in the vehicle registration document as the registered keeper of the vehicle or the person who has the use of such vehicle in the course of his / her employment and who is entitled to use such vehicle as though he / she were the registered keeper thereof;

"civil enforcement officer " has the same meaning as in Section 76(1) and 76(2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

"parking place" means any parking place specified as a pay and display parking place in the Plans for the leaving of vehicles or any off-street parking place described in the schedules to this Order.

"parking permit" means a permit (virtual or physical) issued under the provisions of Articles 69 to 80 inclusive of this Order.

"permit holder" means a person to whom a parking permit has been issued under the provisions of this Order.

"permitted hours" means the periods specified for each parking place during which waiting by vehicles of a specific class is permitted as specified on the on-street Plans and in the schedules to this Order.

"public service vehicle" has the same meaning as Section 1 of the Public Passenger vehicles Act 1981.

"passenger carrying vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;

"relevant position" in respect of: -

(a) a disabled person's badge and parking disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England)

### Regulations 2000; and

(b) a pay and display ticket (virtual or physical) or any physical permit referred to within this Order means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit/ticket is clearly legible from outside the vehicle. Where provision is made for the purchase of a virtual permit, the corresponding vehicle may park without physically displaying a permit. In such circumstances, reference to electronic proof of purchase will be the means of confirming the validity of the permit.

"specified position" means wholly within an area appropriate to the class of vehicle indicated by white lines on the surface of the parking place, or as indicated by signs in the parking place and/or as instructed by a civil enforcement officer.

"Staff Permits" means permits issued by the Council to its members of staff which entitles holders to park within Council long stay pay and display car parks located within the towns in which they are working, subject to the conditions of this Order.

"All Island Car Park Permits" means permits issued by the Council which entitles the holder to parking unlimited in any long stay off street parking places and up to 2 hours parking in short stay off street parking places.

"ticket machine" has the same meaning as in Section 35(3B) of the Act of 1984.

"trailer" has the same meaning as in Section 136(1) of the Act of 1984.

"vehicle" means any heavy commercial vehicle, invalid carriage, motor car, motor cycle, motor vehicle, public service vehicle or trailer as defined in this Article.

### ON STREET PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

### Designation of on street pay and display parking places

- 5. The parts of roads identified as such on the Plans, and detailed within Schedule 2 to this Order, are hereby designated to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as pay and display parking places and may be used subject to the provisions of this Order on such days and during such hours as are specified in the Plans/Schedules.
- 6. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours unless it is of the specified class and there is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position a pay and display ticket or permit, or the vehicle is in possession of a virtual permit, which is valid for that time and for that parking place. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking this method of payment may be used as an alternative to purchasing a 'pay and display' ticket as described above.

### Classes of vehicles for which parking places are designated

7. Subject to the provisions of this Order, pay and display parking places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving of motor cars, motor vehicles, motor cycles, disabled persons' vehicles and invalid carriages, Provided that the motor car, motor vehicle, motor cycle, disabled persons' vehicle or invalid carriage is waiting so that every part of the vehicle is wholly within the marked limits of a parking space.

### Maximum period of waiting

- 8. Save as provided in Articles 22 and 30, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to remain in a pay and display parking place for longer than the maximum period specified for that parking place in Schedule 2.
- 9. Save as provided in Articles 22 and 30, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle which has been taken away from a parking place specified in Schedule 2, and in the Plans, to be left again in the same road until the time for which any return is prohibited has expired.

### Ticket machines to be installed at pay and display parking places

- 10. The Council will -
  - (a) install in such positions at or in the vicinity of a parking place as it may think fit such pay and display ticket machines as are required by this Order for the purposes of that parking place; and
  - (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

### Payment

11. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place where payment is required shall, upon parking the vehicle, obtain a pay and display ticket at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Schedule 2. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking payment of the relevant charge must be made immediately upon parking the vehicle.

### Means of payment

12. The charge referred to in the preceding Article shall be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin, coins, or other approved method of payment, together making up the amount of the charge into the pay and display ticket machine relative to the parking place in which the vehicle has been left. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking this method of payment may be used as an alternative to purchasing a pay and display ticket from the ticket machine. Payment of the relevant charge must be made immediately upon parking the vehicle. The driver of a vehicle using this means of payment may park without physically displaying a valid ticket. In such circumstances, reference to electronic proof of purchase will be the means of confirming this method of payment.

### Display of ticket

- 13. The driver of the vehicle shall
  - (i) display the pay and display ticket issued on payment of the charge in the relevant position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued, and
  - (ii) ensure that a pay and display ticket is purchased and displayed to cover the entire period that the vehicle is parked in the parking place.

### Validity of Pay and Display Tickets

14. A pay and display ticket is not transferable from one vehicle to another.

- 15. A pay and display ticket is valid only in the parking place in respect of which it was issued. This is defined by the identification on the parking ticket machine located in respect of that parking place and the information printed on the pay and display ticket.
- 16. A ticket purchased outside of the chargeable hours is deemed to be valid for the appropriate period of time from the commencement of the next chargeable period.

### Expiry of parking period

17. The expiry of the period for which the charge has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing ticket machine is later than the expiry time exhibited on the pay and display ticket displayed on the vehicle. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking, and payment has been made electronically, the expiry of the period for which the charge has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing ticket machine is later than the expiration time of the period paid for.

### No ticket displayed

- 18. If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place no pay and display ticket is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position, and payment has not been made in accordance with Article 12, it shall be judged that the charge has not been paid.
- 19. If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a pay and display parking place and on the nearest ticket machine in that parking place there is a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council, indicating that the pay and display ticket machine is out of order, then a pay and display ticket shall be obtained from another parking ticket machine relative to that parking zone (where provided).

### Restriction on removal of tickets

20. Where a pay and display ticket has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 13 no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

### Exemptions from payment

- 21. If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a pay and display parking place there is on all the ticket machines relative to that parking place a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council indicating that the said ticket machine is out of order, that vehicle shall be exempt from payment of the charge provided that it is removed within the maximum period of waiting specified for that parking place on the on street Plans.
- 22. Any vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid permit, disabled persons badge or waiver certificate issued by the Council shall be exempt from payment of the parking charge. This will also apply to a vehicle in possession of a valid virtual permit, provided that in all of the circumstances the vehicle is being used in accordance with the conditions applying to the said permit, badge or certificate.

### **Trailers**

- 23. The driver of a motor vehicle drawing a trailer shall be deemed to be the driver of each of the vehicles.
- 24. No person shall leave a trailer in any pay and display parking place unless the trailer is attached to the towing vehicle and a separate ticket, for the same charge applicable to

the towing vehicle, is purchased for the trailer and displayed within the towing vehicle alongside the ticket purchased for the towing vehicle itself. If payment is made by mobile telephone the appropriate charge must be paid for both the towing vehicle and the trailer.

### Restriction on use of an on-street parking place

25. No person shall use a vehicle whilst in a parking place in connection with the sale of goods or services to persons in or near the parking place without the written consent of the Council or utilise any vehicle for the distribution or display of advertising material or shall place upon, or in, any vehicle any advertising matter whatsoever.

### Power to suspend parking places

- 26. Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a pay and display parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary,
  - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
  - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or traffic sign.
  - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling-house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
  - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be throughd or obstructed; or
  - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- 27. A Police Officer in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a pay and display parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- 28. Any person suspending the use of a pay and display parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of the two preceding Articles shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that pay and display parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- 29. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any pay and display parking place or part of a parking place during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part of a parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of Article 28, Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle being used for operational purposes to be left in a pay and display parking place or part of a

pay and display parking place during any such period, or to any other vehicle so left if that vehicle is left with the permission

- (a) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or the part thereof,
  - (b) of a Police Constable in uniform, or
  - (c) a civil enforcement officer.

### Waiver certificate

30. Nothing in Article 6 shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any pay and display parking place if it is displaying in a conspicuous position and legible from the near side of the vehicle a valid waiver certificate issued by the Council and the vehicle is waiting in accordance with the terms and conditions of the said certificate.

### OFF STREET PARKING PLACES

### Designation and use of off-street parking places

- 31. Subject to the provisions of this order, the parking places specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 and the off-street parking places specified in column 1 of Schedule 4 are hereby designated as off-street parking places where vehicles of a specific class may wait.
- 32. Each parking place may be used only subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such classes of vehicles, in such positions, during such hours and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to that parking place in Schedule 3.
- 33. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any position within any parking place that is not a parking bay defined by white lines on the surface of the parking place and / or signs or as instructed by a civil enforcement officer.
- 34. Where in Schedules 3 and 4 a parking place, or part of a parking place, is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or parking permit and is so indicated by notices exhibited in the parking place, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in that parking place or part of a parking place unless:
  - (a) It is of the specified class,
  - (b) It is parked in the specified position (as defined in Article 4), or
  - (c) directed to do so by a civil enforcement officer.
  - (d) It holds the specified parking permit.
- 35. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait so unreasonably as to obstruct or to prevent access to any other parking place, parking bay or any other premises adjoining the parking place, or so as to be a nuisance to any other user of the parking place.
- 36. No person shall permit a vehicle of any class to wait at any time at the locations specified in Schedule 5.

### Closure of off-street parking places

- 37. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council, by a notice displayed at the off-street parking place, from:
  - (a) closing the parking place or any part thereof for any period:
  - (b) setting aside for use only by specially authorised vehicles of part or parts of a parking place on all days or on certain days or during certain parts of certain days.
  - (c) enabling free parking to take place at any parking place for a specific duration or purpose.

### Maximum period of waiting

38. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to remain in a parking place for longer than the maximum period specified for that parking place in Schedules 3 and 4, unless it is displaying in the relevant position a permit or waiver certificate issued by the Council which exempts the holder from the maximum period of waiting, and the vehicle is waiting in accordance with the terms and conditions of the said permit/certificate.

### Ticket machines to be installed at parking places

- 39. In those parking places where payment is required, the Council will
  - (a) install in such positions at or in the vicinity of a parking place as it may think fit such pay and display ticket machines as are required by this Order for the purposes of that parking place; and
  - (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

### <u>Payment</u>

40. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place where payment is required shall, upon leaving the vehicle in the parking place, and on payment of a charge, purchase a pay and display ticket at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Schedule 3. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking payment of the relevant charge must be made immediately upon parking the vehicle.

### Means of payment

41. The charge referred to in the preceding Article shall be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin, coins, or other approved method of payment, together making up the amount of the charge into the pay and display ticket machine relative to the parking place in which the vehicle has been left. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking this method of payment may be used as an alternative to purchasing a pay and display ticket from the ticket machine. Payment of the relevant charge must be made immediately upon parking the vehicle. The driver of a vehicle using this means of payment may park without physically displaying a valid ticket. In such circumstances, reference to electronic proof of purchase will be the means of confirming this method of payment.

### Display of ticket

- 42. The driver of the vehicle shall
  - (a) display the pay and display ticket, in the relevant position, on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued, and
  - (b) ensure that a pay and display ticket is purchased or obtained and displayed to cover the entire period that the vehicle is parked in the parking place.

### Validity of Pay and Display Tickets

- 43. A pay and display ticket is not transferable from one vehicle to another.
- 44. A pay and display ticket is valid only in the parking place in respect of which it was issued. This is defined by the identification on the parking ticket machine located in respect of that parking place and the information printed on the pay and display ticket.
- 45. A ticket purchased outside of the chargeable hours is deemed to be valid for the appropriate period of time from the commencement of the next chargeable period.

### Expiry of parking period

46. The expiry of the period for which the charge has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing ticket machine is later than the expiry time exhibited on the pay and display ticket displayed on the vehicle. Where provision is made for mobile telephone parking, and payment of the charge has been made electronically, the expiry of the period for which the charge has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing ticket machine is later than the expiration time of the period paid for.

### No ticket displayed

- 47. If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place no pay and display ticket is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position, and payment has not been made in accordance with Article 41, it shall be judged that the charge has not been paid.
- 48. If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a parking place and on the nearest ticket machine in that parking place there is a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council, indicating that the pay and display ticket machine is out of order, then a pay and display ticket shall be obtained from another parking ticket machine relative to that parking place (where provided).

### Restriction on removal of tickets

49. Where a pay and display ticket has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 42 no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

### Exemptions from payment

50. If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a pay and display parking place there is on all the ticket machines relative to that parking place a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council indicating that the said ticket machine is out of order, that vehicle shall be exempt from payment of the charge

- provided that it is removed within the maximum period of waiting specified for that parking place.
- 51. Any vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid permit, disabled persons badge or waiver certificate issued by the Council shall be exempt from payment of the parking charge. This will also apply to a vehicle in possession of a valid virtual permit, provided that in all of the circumstances the vehicle is being used in accordance with the conditions applying to the said permit, badge or certificate.

### **Trailers**

- 52. The driver of a motor vehicle drawing a trailer shall be deemed to be the driver of each of the vehicles.
- 53. No person shall leave a trailer in any pay and display parking place unless the trailer is attached to the towing vehicle and a separate ticket, for the same charge applicable to the towing vehicle, is purchased for the trailer and displayed within the towing vehicle alongside the ticket purchased for the towing vehicle itself. If payment is made by mobile telephone the appropriate charge must be paid for both the towing vehicle and the trailer.
- 54. Where specific provision is made in any parking place for the parking, or storage, of trailers such a facility shall be used as indicated by signs in the parking place and/or as instructed by a civil enforcement officer, or duly authorised officer of the Council.

### Restriction on use of an off-street parking place

- 55. Where in a parking place signs are erected, or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:
  - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place, or
  - (b) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place,
- 56. No person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle:
  - (i) so that it enters the parking place other than by the entrance, or leaves the parking place otherwise than by the exit so indicated, or
  - (ii) in a direction other than so specified.
- 57. No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in an off street parking place for any purpose other than leaving the vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place unless gaining access to, and egress from, an adjacent property or disposing of materials in a recycling facility.
- 58. No person shall, whilst a vehicle or trailer is in an off-street parking place permit to be carried out any work, maintenance or repair to that vehicle other than may be necessary to enable the vehicle or trailer to be moved from the parking place.
- 59. The driver of a vehicle in a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the off-street parking place and shall not start the engine except for the purpose of changing the position of the vehicle in the parking place or departing from it.

- 60. No person shall use a vehicle whilst in a parking place: -
  - (a) in connection with the sale of goods or services to persons in or near the parking place without the written consent of the Council or utilise any vehicle for the distribution or display of advertising material or shall place upon, or in, any vehicle any advertising matter whatsoever,
    - (b) as sleeping accommodation or for camping, cooking or sanitary purposes whether by day or night and shall not use the parking place for any purpose other than parking the vehicle,
    - (c) display the vehicle for sale.
- 61. No person shall whilst in a parking place: -
  - (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or any other structure without the written consent of the Council, or light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.
  - (b) wantonly shout or make any noise to the disturbance or annoyance of the users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.
  - (c) skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or any other mechanical contrivance.
  - (d) cause or permit any animal to be exercised, loaded or unloaded in any parking place except in the case of a dog provided it is kept on a lead except with the authorisation of the Council.
  - (e) without reasonable excuse fail to remove forthwith any faeces deposited by the dog in the parking place.

### Loading Bays

- 62. Where part of a parking place is designated for loading only no vehicle shall wait within that parking place unless;
  - (a) the vehicle is being used for the purposes of loading or unloading; and
  - (b) that the vehicle shall not wait for a period of longer than the period specified by the signs within the parking place.

### Setting Down Points and Electric Vehicle Bays

63. Where part of a parking place is designated for the setting down of passengers no vehicle shall wait within the parking place for a period longer than that specified by the signs. Where bays within a parking place are designated for electric vehicles to recharge their supply, no vehicle shall wait within the bay unless the vehicle is a plug-in electric or plug-in hybrid electric motor vehicle, charging, and waits for no longer than the hours specified by the signs.

### **GENERAL**

### Removal of vehicles

- 64. When a vehicle is left in a pay and display or off-street parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, a person authorised on behalf of the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place.
- 65. Any person removing a vehicle by virtue of the preceding Article may do so by towing, or driving, the vehicle or trailer or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it as aforesaid.
- 66. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle or trailer from a parking place he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle. Any costs incurred in the removal of that vehicle or trailer will be the responsibility of the registered keeper or driver.
- 67. Where gates are provided at the entrance/exit of a parking place and locked between the times displayed at that parking place and the driver, or owner, of a vehicle requires the removal of that vehicle the driver, or owner, shall be responsible for the payment of an appropriate call out fee specified in the notice displayed at that parking place prior to an authorised officer of the Council releasing that vehicle.

### Movement of vehicles

68. Where a vehicle is standing in a pay and display or off-street parking place in contravention of Articles 32, 33, 34, 35, or 36 of this Order, a person authorised on behalf of the Council or a police officer in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with these provisions.

### Parking permits

- 69. The owner of a vehicle may, on application to the Council, purchase a parking permit for a charge ascertained by reference to the charge and class of vehicle specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and that parking permit shall be valid in such parking places as are specified therein during the period for which it is issued.
- 70. Persons whose normal place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is:
  - (a) In a street or esplanade for which parking charges as specified in Schedule 2 of this Order are in operation, or
  - (b) Within a 100-metre radius of Cowes Parade or a 200-metre radius of an off-street car park specified in Schedule 3 of this Order,

may apply for either a Residents Pay and Display On-Street Permit, Cowes Parade Residents' Permit or a Residents' Nominated Car Park Permit, at the relevant charge set out in Schedule 1 to this Order, provided that:

- (i) No such permits shall be issued where an on-street residents' parking scheme is in operation,
- (ii) No such permits shall be issued where there is off-street parking available to the applicant, and
- (iii) Only two permits per postal address shall be issued.

- 71. Applications for parking permits shall be made to the Isle of Wight Council, County Hall, High Street, Newport, Isle of Wight, PO30 1UD and other locations authorised by the Isle of Wight Council and shall include such particulars as may be required.
- 72. The issue of a parking permit to any applicant shall be at the discretion of the Council.
- 73. Except in the case of a virtual permit, the parking permit shall be displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle to which it relates whenever that vehicle is in the said parking places for the purpose of parking therein. Where in the schedules to this Order a parking place is designated for the use of specific permit holders, the appropriate permit must be displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle.
- 74. Parking permits are not transferable between vehicles, except in the case of staff permits upon which two vehicle registration marks can be specified. In the event of a permit holder disposing of a vehicle to which a permit applies and acquiring another, the permit shall be surrendered, and a replacement issued on payment of the appropriate administration charge specified in Schedule 1.
- 75. If a permit is: -
  - (a) mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, or
  - (b) lost or destroyed,
- 76. The permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate permit and the Council, upon being satisfied as to the reasons for the application, shall issue a duplicate permit so marked, and upon such issue the original permit shall become invalid. An administrative charge specified in Schedule 1 shall be made by the Council for the issue of such a duplicate permit.
- 77. A permit holder who surrenders a valid permit to the Council shall be entitled to a refund calculated on a pro rata basis in respect of each complete month remaining until the permit expires. An administration charge specified in Schedule 1 shall be made by the Council and deducted from any refund made.
- 78. No person shall cause a vehicle in possession of an All Island Car Park Permit to wait for longer than 2 hours in a short stay off street parking place designated in Schedule 3. Where a vehicle in possession of an All Island Car Park Permit has been taken away from a short stay off street parking place designated in Schedule 3, it may not return until a period of at least 2 hours has elapsed.
- 79. No person shall cause a vehicle displaying a Staff Permit to park within a long stay car park designated in Schedule 3, or an off street car park designated in Schedule 4 to this Order, that is not situated within the town in which the member of staff is based or working. Where part of a parking place is designated for Staff Permit holders only, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in that part of a parking place unless a valid Staff Permit is held and provided the vehicle waits for no longer than the maximum waiting period permitted as indicated by the notices exhibited in the parking place.
- 80. No person shall cause a vehicle in possession of an All Island Car Park Permit to wait for longer than 2 hours in a short stay off street parking place designated in Schedule 3. Where a vehicle in possession of an All Island Car Park Permit has been taken away from a short stay off street parking place designated in Schedule 3, it may not return until a period of at least 2 hours has elapsed.

### Disabled person's badge

- 81. Notwithstanding the provisions of Articles 11 and 40 of this Order a vehicle displaying a disabled persons' badge in the relevant position is exempt from certain requirements provided that at the time the vehicle was left in the parking place it was being used by the person to whom the badge was issued or under Section 21(4) (institutional use) of the Chronically Sick & Disabled Persons Act 1970 as amended.
- 82. Unless otherwise directed by signs and directions posted at the relevant pay and display parking place, no person shall cause a vehicle displaying a disabled persons' badge to wait for longer than three hours in a short stay off street parking place and eight hours in a long stay off street parking place and shall not return to that parking place until a period of at least three hours from the time of departure has expired. Nothing within this Article will apply to a person displaying a disabled persons' badge in Dinosaur Island, Sandown, or Cross Street Car Park, where waiting is unlimited.
- 83. Vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons' badge in the relevant position may be left for periods longer than those specified in Article 82 if at the time they first leave the vehicle in the parking place they purchase a ticket for any additional period that does not exceed the maximum stay permitted for that parking place.

### Contravention

84. If a vehicle is left in any of the on street or off-street parking places defined in the schedules to this Order in contravention of, or without complying with, the requirements of this Order a contravention shall have occurred, and a penalty charge shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed from that location.

### Penalty charge notice

- 85. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of the officer / civil enforcement officer to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:
  - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
  - (b) the grounds on which the civil enforcement officer believes that a penalty charge is payable in respect of that vehicle;
  - (c) the amount of penalty charge required to be paid;
  - (d) that if the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days, beginning with the date of the notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced by the specified proportion or amount;
  - (e) that if a challenge is received against the penalty charge within 14 days and the challenge is rejected the Council will generally extend the period within which the reduced Penalty Charge may be paid;
  - (f) that all representations against the penalty charge received by the Council before the end of the 28-day period will be considered by the Council;

- (g) that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28-day period a notice to owner may be served by the Council on the person appearing to be the owner of the vehicle; and
- (h) the address to which payment of the penalty charge can be made.

### Manner of payment of penalty charge


- 86. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council within 28 days of the issue of the penalty charge notice either;
  - (a) by cheque, bankers' draft, money order or postal order delivered to any Isle of Wight Council office which accepts such payments, or
  - (b) by cheque, postal order, in cash, by credit card or debit card in person at any Isle of Wight Council office, or authorised location, which accepts such payments, or
  - (c) by credit card or debit card over the phone, via the Council's website, or any other approved method, by using the number specified on the penalty charge notice, together with any further particulars which may be required.
- 87. Provided that, if the said twenty-eight day falls upon a day on which the said department or office is closed, the period within which payment of the said charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 4.00 pm on the next full day on which the said department is open.
- 88. If the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days beginning with the date of the notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced by 50%.
- 89. If the owner fails to pay the penalty charge by the end of the 28-day period, a notice of owner may be served; and if the charge is not paid within a further 28 days it may be increased by 50% on the issue of a charge certificate.
- 90. Continuing failure to pay the penalty charge may result in the charge being registered as a debt with the Traffic Enforcement Centre to enable the Council to recover any balance due.

### Indications as evidence

91. The particulars given in the penalty charge notice attached to a vehicle in accordance with Article 85 shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such penalty charge.

### Restriction on removal of notices

92. Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 85 no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, a police officer in uniform, civil enforcement officer or some other person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the owner of the vehicle.
