THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF KING'S LYNN AND WEST NORFOLK (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2013

The Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk, in exercise of their powers under sections 32, 35, 38 and with the consent of Norfolk County Council under section 39 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("hereinafter referred to as the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

PART 1

GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of November 2013, and may be cited as The Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013.

Interpretation

2(1) In this Order:-

"agent" means a person or organisation appointed by the Enforcement Authority to accept payment of Penalty Charge Notices as displayed on the reverse of the Penalty Charge Notice;

"authorised taxi rank" means any area of the parking place which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"authorised vehicle" means a vehicle which has received prior authority from the Council to proceed and wait in the "authorised vehicle bay" at the southern end of Parking Place No 28 (Tuesday Market Place);

"authorised vehicle bay" is the parking bay marked at the southern end of Parking Place No 28 (Tuesday Market Place) for authorised vehicles to wait in accordance with the authority provided by the Council;

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22(2) of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"Charging Hours" means the periods specified in Column 5 of the Schedules to this Order in respect of which a charge is made as specified in Article 3;

"Council" means The Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk:

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"Cycle" has the same meaning as in section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988"

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place, or the person deemed to be the driver under the terms of this Order;

"Disabled Parking Bay" means an area of the parking place indicated as such as an area where a vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, may be stationed;

"Disabled Person's Vehicles" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000:

"Disabled Persons Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000; and

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No 3551: 1970), but coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hours period during which a period of waiting begins; and

for the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when

- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen
 - (i) the badge is exhibited facing forwards of the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) the parking disc is exhibited in the relevant position with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen, and
- (b in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge or disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the side of the vehicle.

"Enforcement Authority" means the Council;

"Excursion or tour" has the same meaning as in s137(1) of the Transport Act 1985(a);

"General Regulations 2007" shall mean The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

"Hackney Carriage" has the meaning as in Section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847:

"Heavy Commercial Vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 138 of the 1984 Act;

"Motor Car", "Motor Cycle" and "Invalid Carriage" shall have the same meaning as in section 136 of the 1984 Act;

"Motor Cycle Parking Area" means an area of the parking place indicated as such as an area where a motor cycle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, may be stationed:

"Motor Caravan" shall have the same meaning as in section 3 of The Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;

"OAP" in relation to Schedule 4 of this Order shall mean a person of pensionable age; and

"Pensionable age" shall have the same meaning as in s150(2) of The Social Security Contribution and Benefits Act 1992:

"Parking Bay" means an area of the parking place indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place as an area where a vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, may be stationed;

"Parking Charge" means the sum of money specified in Column 6 of the Schedules to this Order;

"Penalty Charge" has the same meaning as in section 2 of the General Regulations 2007;

"Penalty Charge Notice" has the same meaning as in section 8 of the General Regulations 2007;

"Parking Place" means the area of land specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order provided by the Council for use as a parking place;

"Private Service Vehicle" means a bus being used as part of an excursion or tour:

"Public Service Vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Ticket Machine" means the apparatus provided at the Parking Place, being an apparatus for issuing parking tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the date and time at which the charge was paid;

"Trailer" has the same meaning as in section 3 of The Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986.

"Voucher Parking Bay" means a Parking Bay within the designated area (21 bays in total) at the southern end of Parking Place No 28 (Tuesday Market Parking Place) (known as Parking Place No 28A and Parking Place No 28B) where:-

- (i) a vehicle in accordance with this Order may be stationed for a maximum period of 20 minutes;
- (ii) a disabled persons vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in accordance with this Order may be stationed in a disabled persons parking bay or parking bay for a maximum period of 20 minutes; subject to the provisions of this Order.

2(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

PART II DESIGNATION, CHARGES AND PENALTY CHARGES

Classes and position of vehicles

- Each Parking Place may be used, subject to provisions of this Order, as a parking place for the classes of vehicles to be stationed in the appropriate parking bays on the days and during the hours, and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to the parking place in the Schedules to this Order.
- Where in the Schedules to this Order the Parking Place is described, or where a Parking Bay is designated by surface or other markings, as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place, or parking bay, unless it is of the specified class.
- 5(1) Subject to the Parking Place having marked Parking Bays, no vehicles shall be left in the parking place other than wholly within a parking bay.
- 5(2) No vehicle shall be left or allowed to stand in the parking place in such a position as to obstruct:-
 - (i) the entrance thereto or the exit therefrom the parking place, nor
 - (ii) the waste receptacles within the parking place.
- 5(3) No vehicle shall be left or allowed to stand in the parking place in such a position as to prevent the driving away of any vehicle already standing in the parking place or in such a position as to cause an obstruction to other vehicles and persons generally.

Payment and Display of Ticket

- 6(1) The driver of a vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place shall, on leaving the vehicle wholly within a Parking Bay (where marked in the Parking Place) and prior to leaving the Parking Place pay the appropriate Parking Charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in column 6 of Schedules 1 to 3 to this Order. Where a vehicle or vehicle and trailer occupies more than one Parking Bay the driver shall pay the appropriate Parking Charge for the total number of parking bays occupied by those vehicles.
- 6(2) The rider of a motor cycle using a Parking Place:-
 - which contains a designated motor cycle parking area may park that motor cycle wholly within that designated motor cycle parking area of the Parking Place without payment of the Parking Charge;
 - (ii) must, if parked within any other parking bay within a Parking Place, pay the appropriate parking charge as specified in Article 6(1) of this Order.

- 6(3) The Parking Charge referred to in Article 6(1) at will be payable by:-
 - (i) the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into a ticket machine. The driver having paid the Parking Charge will be issued with a ticket via the ticket machine; or
 - (ii) other means as authorised by the Council and prominently displayed on a board at the Parking Place.
- 6(4) The driver of a vehicle using a Voucher Parking Bay within the designated area at the southern end of Parking Place No 28, known as Parking Place 28A and Parking Place 28B in the Schedule to this Order (Tuesday Market Parking Place) shall, on leaving the vehicle wholly within a Voucher Parking Bay and prior to leaving the Parking Place obtain a ticket via the appropriate ticket machine situated at the southern end of Parking Place No 28 (Tuesday Market Parking Place).
- 6(5) The driver of a vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Voucher Parking Bay in accordance with Articles 6(1), 6(2)(ii), 6(3)(i), 6(4) and 6(9) of this Order, and:-
 - (i) which vehicle possesses a windscreen shall display the ticket or voucher issued by a Ticket Machine, within the vehicle either by attaching it firmly to the front windscreen or by placing it on the dashboard of the vehicle;
 - (ii) which vehicle does not possess a windscreen shall display the ticket or voucher issued by a Ticket Machine in a conspicuous position,

so that the payment in accordance with the scale of charges appropriate to the Parking Place as specified in the Schedules to this Order, the day, date and time of issue and all other particulars shown are clearly visible from outside the vehicle during the entire period the vehicle is waiting in the Parking Place. A ticket or voucher which is not displayed in accordance with this clause is not valid.

- 6(6) Any voucher issued for a Voucher Parking Bay or ticket issued on payment of the Parking Charge referred to in Article 6(1) for a Pay and Display Parking Place is not transferable and shall not be valid for any vehicle (whether or not that other vehicle is owned or is under the control of the driver) other than that for which it was originally purchased by the driver.
- 6(7) The driver of a vehicle using a Pay on Exit/Pay on Foot Parking place shall, on arriving at the Parking Place take a Parking Ticket from the Ticket Machine to establish the time of entry at the Parking Place and shall on return to the vehicle prior to exit pay the appropriate Parking Charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in column 6 of Schedules 1 to 3 of this Order.
- 6(8) The Parking Charge referred to in Article 6(7) of this Order will be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the Pay on Exit/Pay on Foot ticket machine or by other means as authorised by the Council and prominently displayed on a board at the Parking Place.

- 6(9) The driver of a vehicle may subject to the Council's discretion and on application to the Council purchase a season ticket for a vehicle to wait in a Parking Place as specified in Schedule 4 to this order in respect of that vehicle. Any season ticket issued by the Council in accordance with this Article will specify the vehicle permitted by the driver to wait in a Parking Bay and also the Parking Place to which the season ticket applies. The driver of the vehicle specified on the season ticket may use a Parking Place without payment of the Parking Charges specified in Article 6(1) and Column 6 of Schedules 1 to 3 provided that the season ticket is valid and is displayed in accordance with Article 6(4) of this Order.
- 6(10)A season ticket issued to the driver of a specified vehicle shall not be valid on any vehicle other than that vehicle for which it was originally purchased by the driver (whether or not that other vehicle is owned or is under the control of the driver).

Disabled person's parking

- 7(1) The driver of a vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge may (subject to compliance with all other provisions of this Order) park that vehicle in a designated disabled parking bay provided that:
 - (a) the driver of the vehicle is a disabled person to whom the badge was issued in respect of that vehicle,
 - (b) the vehicle is being used for the carriage of a disabled person to whom the badge was issued,
 - (c) the vehicle is one being used for the carriage of disabled persons by an institution to whom the badge was issued in respect of that vehicle; or
 - (d) the time during which the vehicle will be parked in the said parking bay is indicated on the parking disc provided by local authority for that purpose.
- 7(2) Subject to compliance with all other Articles of this order, a disabled person's vehicle parked in:
 - a disabled parking bay within the parking place and displaying a valid disabled persons badge and parking disc in accordance with Article 2(1) of this Order; or
 - (ii) a parking bay and displaying a valid disabled persons badge or parking disc, in accordance with Article 2(1) of this Order, when no disabled parking bays are available;

may wait for up to an additional 30 minutes from the time of expiry of their Parking Ticket at all Pay and Display Car Parks before a Penalty Charge Notice will be issued.

This Article does apply to the following Parking Places;-

- (i) Parking Place No 18 (St James Multi-Storey Car Park), and
- (ii) Parking Places No 28A and 28B (being the Voucher Parking Bays at the southern end of Parking Place numbered 28 (Tuesday Market Car Park),

in Schedule 1 to this Order.

- 7(3) Subject to compliance with all other Articles of this order, a disabled person's vehicle parked in:
 - (i) Parking Places No 28A and 29B (being the Voucher Parking Bays at the southern end of Parking Place numbered 28 (Tuesday Market Car Park) may wait for up to an additional 10 minutes from the time of expiry of their Parking Voucher before a Penalty Charge Notice will be issued.

Penalty Charge and Penalty Charge Notice

- 8(1) Where a driver has left a vehicle in a Parking Place in contravention of this Order a Penalty Charge shall become payable. A Penalty Charge Notice to that effect will be attached to the vehicle or handed to the driver by a Civil Enforcement Officer, in accordance with Article 8(4) of this Order.
- 8(2) A Penalty Charge shall be payable to the Enforcement Authority.
- 8(3) In the event of payment of the Penalty Charge being received by the Enforcement Authority within 14 days of the day in which it was incurred the amount of penalty charge will be discounted in accordance with Regulation 5 of the General Regulations 2007.
- 8(4). A Penalty Charge Notice referred to in Article 8(1) and issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer shall include the following particulars:
 - (a) the enforcement authority,
 - (b) the parking place at which the contravention occurred (which may be identified on the Penalty Charge Notice by an abbreviation or code),
 - (c) the registration mark of the vehicle or when the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the registration mark of that trade licence,
 - (d) the date, time at which the Penalty Charge was seen to be payable,
 - (e) the grounds on which the Civil Enforcement Officer serving the Penalty Charge Notice believes that a Penalty Charge is payable,
 - (f) the amount of the Penalty Charge,
 - (g) the manner in which and time within which the Penalty Charge shall be payable.

- (h) a statement that a reduced charge may be payable if payment is made within fourteen days of the Penalty Charge Notice being incurred,
- (i) a statement to the effect that if the Penalty Charge is not paid before the end of the period of 28 days a notice to owner may be served by the Enforcement Authority on the owner of the vehicle.
- 9(1) Where a driver has left a vehicle in a Parking Place in contravention of this Order and a Penalty Charge Notice could not be issued as specified in Article 8(1) of this Order a Penalty Charge Notice may be issued by post by the enforcement authority in accordance with section 10 of the General Regulations 2007.
- 9(2) Any Penalty Charge Notice issued in accordance with Article 9(1) of this Order shall, in addition to the particulars specified in 8(4)(a), (b), (c), (e) and (f) of this Order, include the particulars specified in paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the General Regulations 2007.
- 10(1)The Penalty Charge referred to in Article 8(1) shall be paid to the Enforcement Authority or an agent acting on behalf of the Enforcement Authority in accordance with the instructions on the reverse of the Penalty Charge Notice.
- 10(2) The driver of a vehicle in respect of which a Penalty Charge has been incurred shall pay the Penalty Charge or provide proof of payment of the Penalty Charge to the Enforcement Authority as detailed on the reverse of the Notice within 28 days of the date on which the notice is served. If payment is received within a period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the notice is served the amount of the said charge shall be reduced by 50% (provided that if the fourteenth day falls upon a day on which the Enforcement Authority's offices are closed the period within which payment of the said charge is due shall be extended to 1.00 p.m. on the next full day on which the office is open).
- 10(3)Where a driver of a vehicle fails to pay the Penalty Charge as specified in Articles 10(1) and 10(2) of this Order the Enforcement Authority may follow the procedures set out in the General Regulations 2007 to recover the Penalty Charge.
- 10(4)A driver who desires to make representation to or appeal against a Penalty Charge Notice issued to him may make representation or appeal to the Enforcement Authority pursuant to the procedures set out in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) Representations and Appeals Regulations 2007.

PART III

USE OF PARKING PLACES

11. The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in a designated parking bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in the parking bay, or to depart from the parking place.

- 12. Except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council, no person shall use a vehicle, whilst it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services except in Car Park Number 28 Tuesday Market Place southernmost end where a Hackney Carriage may wait in an authorised taxi rank as specified in Part II of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.
- 13. Except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council, no person shall distribute any advertising material or affix or cause to be affixed any advertising material to any vehicle left in the parking place.
- 14. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in the parking place in contravention of the provisions of Articles 3, 4, 5(1) and 5(2) of this Order, or it is necessary to meet the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised on behalf of the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place, or may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.
- 15. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 14 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as that person may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as that person may think necessary to enable that person to remove or alter its position.
- 16. When a person authorised by the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Articles 14 and 15 of this Order, that person shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- 17. Where a vehicle has been removed in accordance with Articles 14, 15 and 16 of this Order the charges as specified in section 3 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges)(England) Order 2007 shall become payable.
- 18. Neither such person nor the Council shall be responsible for any loss or damage to the vehicle or to anything contained therein or attached thereto arising from or in consequence of the exercise of the powers in Articles 14, 15, 16 and 17.
- 19. The driver of a motor vehicle using the Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
- 20. No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer, drive any vehicle in the Parking Place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.
- 21. No person shall, in the Parking Place, wantonly shout or otherwise make a loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.

- 22. No person shall in the Parking Place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
- 23. No person shall, except with the authority of the Council or enforcement authority, use any part of the Parking Place or any vehicle left in the Parking Place:
 - (a) for sleeping or camping purposes;
 - (b) for eating or cooking purposes;
 - (c) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the Parking Place:
 - (d) for skateboarding, roller skating or wheeled activities which may be hazardous to pedestrians;
 - (e) for the instruction of pupils whilst undertaking driving lessons.
- 24. No person shall play or take part in any game in the Parking Place.
- 25. No person shall use the Parking Place as a means of passing or proceeding from one road to another road.
- 26. Where in the Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:
 - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place; or
 - (b) indicating that a vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place

no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it

- (i) enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leave the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit so indicated or
- (ii) is in a direction other than that specified

as the case may be.

- 27. In the Parking Place no person shall, except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council:
 - (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure;
 - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.

- 28. No person shall enter Parking Place numbered 22 whilst towing any vehicle except:
 - (i) where the towed vehicle is required in order that a vehicle may be removed in accordance with Article 15 of this Order,
 - (ii) where the towed vehicle is carrying equipment required by the driver for maintenance at the Parking Place,
 - (iii) where the towed vehicle is required for remedial works at or to the Parking Place by Statutory Utilities Staff,
 - (iv) where permission has been granted by the Council or an agent acting on behalf of the Council or a Police Constable in uniform.
- 29. Except in Parking Places numbered 3, 30, 32 and 34 no person shall leave stationed a vehicle, with a maximum gross vehicle weight greater than 3050 Kg, except upon the direction of or with the permission of the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
- 30. When a Penalty Charge Notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 6 no person, not being the driver of the vehicle or a person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the Notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.
- 31. By conspicuous notices to the effect the Council may suspend Parking on the Parking Place or part thereof and failure to observe such notices shall be a contravention of this Order.
- 32. In the Parking Place no person shall leave a vehicle stationed overnight, except upon the direction or with the permission of the Council or an agent acting on behalf the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer.

PART IV

REVOCATION

- 33. The following Order will become revoked and consolidated with this Order on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-
 - "The Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2011" in its entirety;
- 34. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the off-street car parking places specified in the Schedules to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail, EXCEPT WHERE the provisions of this Order conflicts with "The Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation and Variation Order 2011 Variation Notice 2013" where the provision of that Notice will prevail for the dates and times specified (being 28th November 2013, and 5th, 12th and 19th December 2013 from 1500 hrs to 2359 hrs only in the off-street parking places specified on that Notice).
