THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (KING'S LYNN, VARIOUS ROADS) (ONE-WAY AND CONTRA FLOW CYCLE LANE) (No 2) ORDER 2015

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

In this Order:

"Cycle" has the same meaning as in section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

- 1. Save as provided in Articles 2, 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle along the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order in any direction other than the direction specified in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in a south to north direction along the U20408 Tuesday Market Place (east side) from its junction with the C544 St Nicholas Street to the parking area to the rear of Property No 10 Tuesday Market Place (currently Ward Gethin Solicitors) if the vehicle being used requires egress from that parking area to the C544 St Nicholas Street.
- 4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent a person to cause or permit a cycle to proceed in a contra flow direction along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of November 2015 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (King's Lynn, Various Roads) (One-Way and Contra Flow Cycle Lane) (No 2) Order 2015.
- 6. The following Orders will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-
 - "The Norfolk County Council (King's Lynn, Various Roads)(One-Way) Order 2015" in its entirety.
- 7. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
