

KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) ORDER 2016

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees (hereinafter referred to as "the enforcement authority") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Kirklees) Order 2006 together with all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

PART I

1. COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION

This Order shall come into operation on the 17th May 2016 and may be cited as the Kirklees Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 2) Order 2016.

2. INTERPRETATION

2.1 Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order and any reference to a numbered schedule is a reference to the schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. REVOCATIONS

3.1 The orders listed in Column 1 of the First Schedule are hereby revoked to the extent stated in Column 2 of that Schedule.

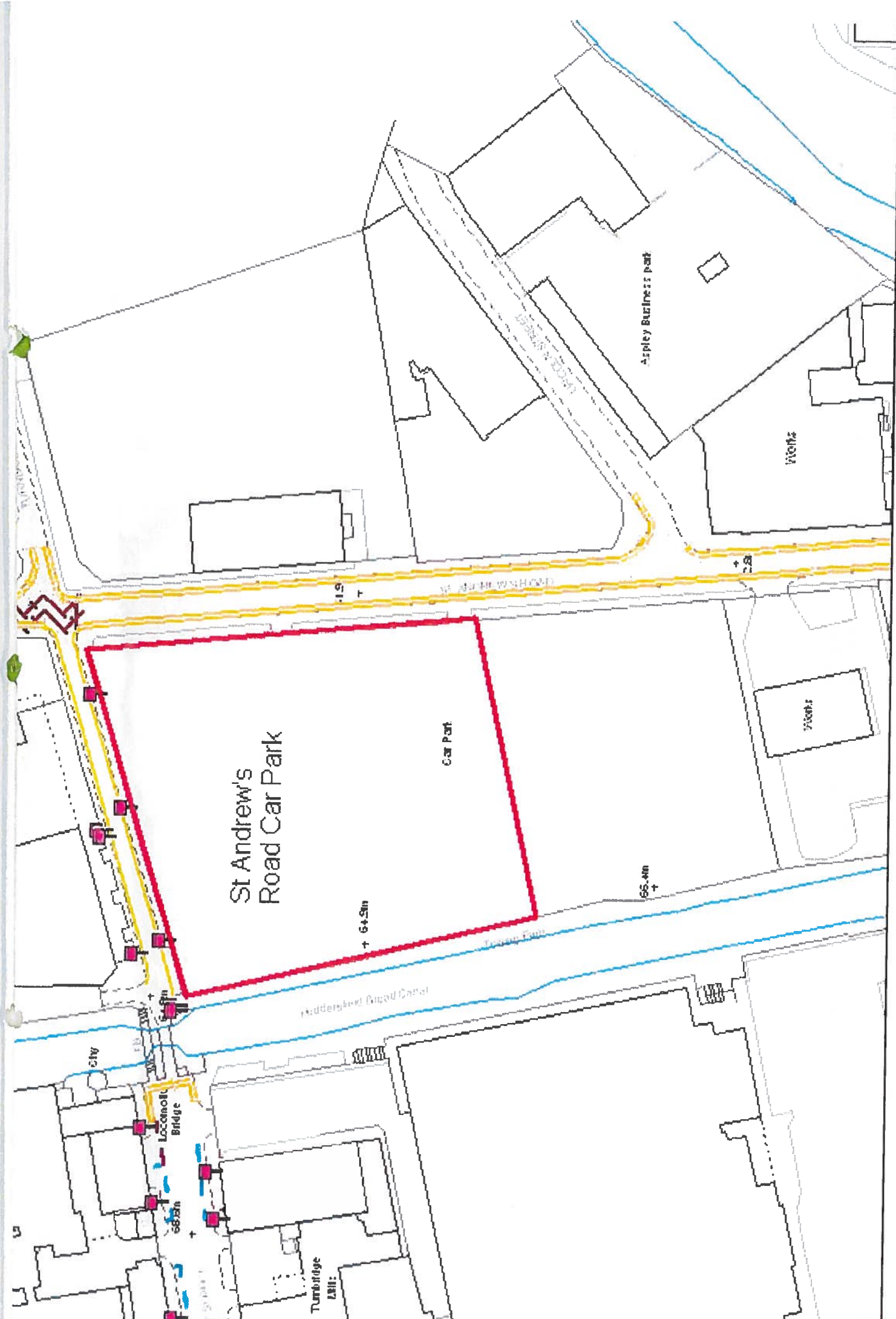

Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order
