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KIRKLEES COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (CLECKHEATON AREA) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Kirklees) Order 2006 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order which relates to roads throughout the Kirklees District:-

PARTI

1. COMMENCEMENT CITATION & REVOCATION

- 1.1. This Order shall come into operation on the 14^{TC} day of November 2018 and may be cited as the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (Cleckheaton Area) (Consolidation) Order 2017
- 1.2. The Orders listed in the Eighteenth Schedule are hereby revoked to the extent cited therein.

2. INTERPRETATION

- 2.1. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order and any reference to a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Schedule bearing that number in this Order
- 2.2. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
 - "Abnormal indivisible load vehicle" has the meaning given by paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Road vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) Order 2003.
 - "Abnormal indivisible load vehicle escort vehicle" means a vehicle undertaking the "self-escort" duties in relation to an abnormal indivisible load vehicle and complying with the Highways Agency's Code of Practice (Self Escorting of Abnormal Loads and Abnormal Vehicles).
 - "Annual charge" in relation to a business parking permit means a sum (being such sum as the Council may from time to time determine) payable by a business permit holder to facilitate the issue or renewal of such a permit by the Council
 - "Authorised position" means in relation to:-
 - (i) Article 4, wholly within the limits of the parking place as marked on the carriageway in accordance with the road markings as indicated by Diagrams 1028.3, 1032 or 1033 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations and in such position so as not to obstruct the movement of other motor vehicles
 - (ii) Article 5, wholly within the limits of the parking place as marked on the carriageway in accordance with the road markings as indicated by Diagrams 1028.4, 1032 or 1033 in

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Schedule 6 to the	2002	Regulations	and	in	such	position	so	as	not	to	obstruct	the
movement of other	motor	vehicles										

- (iii) Article 6, wholly within the limits of the parking place as marked on the carriageway in accordance with the road markings as indicated by Diagrams 1028.3, 1032 or 1033 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations and in such position so as not to obstruct the movement of other motor vehicles
- (iv) Article 11, wholly within the limits of the parking place as marked on the carriageway in accordance with the road markings as indicated in Diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations and in such a position so as not to obstruct the movement of other motor vehicles.

"Bank Holiday" has the same meaning as in the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971.

"Bus lane" means the carriageway specified and described in Column 1 of the Eleventh Schedule and has the same meaning as in the 2002 Regulations

Business parking permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 5.18 "Carriageway" has the same meaning as in Section 329 of the Highways Act 1980.

"Category N1 vehicle" means a vehicle designed and constructed for the carriage of goods and having a maximum mass not exceeding 3.5 tonnes.

"Civil enforcement area" has the meaning given by Schedule 8 of the 2004 Act.

"Civil enforcement officer" has the meaning given by S.76 of the 2004 Act.

"Commercial vehicle" means any motor vehicle which is being used for the delivery and collection of goods.

"Cycle lane" means the area of the carriageway specified and described in Column 1 of the Fourteenth Schedule and has the same meaning as in the 2002 Regulations.

"Designation order" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act

"Disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations and the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.

"Disabled person's motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge and which immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of this Order has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers.

"Driver" in relation to a motor vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the motor vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.

"Dual purpose vehicle" has the same meaning as in Paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 to the Act.

"DVLA" means the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency.

"Enforcement authority" means the Council.

- "Goods" has the same meaning as in the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- "Hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.
- "Invalid carriage" means the same as in Section 136 of the Act.
- "Maximum gross weight" has the same meaning as in the 2002 Regulations.
- "Maximum mass" means the technically permissible maximum laden mass.
- "Motor cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act.
- "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act.
- "Notice to Owner" means a notice served under Regulation 19 of the General Regulations
- "Omnibus" means a motor vehicle travelling to a point at which it will commence to be or from a point at which it will cease to be a public service vehicle, a school bus or a works bus, as the case may be.
- "Open parking permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 5.17.
- "Owner" in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom the vehicle is kept which in the case of a motor vehicle registered under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act, 1994 is presumed (unless the contrary is proved) to be the person in whose name the vehicle is registered.
- "Parking disc" has the same meaning given by regulation 8(5) of the 2000 Regulations
- "Parking place" means in relation to:-
- (i) Article 4 the parts of the road specified in Column 1 of the Ninth Schedule authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place;
- (ii) Article 5 the parts of the road specified in Column 1 of the Eighth Schedule authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place;
- (iii) Article 6 the parts of the road specified in Column 1 of the Tenth Schedule authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.
- (iv) Article 11 the parts of the road specified in Column 1 of the Fifteenth Schedule authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.
- "Passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry no more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver.
- "Pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the 2002 Regulations
- "Penalty charge" has the meaning given by S.92 of the 2004 Act.
- "Penalty charge notice" has the meaning given by Regulation 8 of the General Regulations

- "Permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Articles 5.15 to 5.21 inclusive.
- "Permit holder" means a person to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of Articles 5.15 to 5.21 inclusive.
- "Permitted motor vehicle" means in relation to:-
- (i) Article 4 commercial vehicles;
- (ii) Article 5 a passenger vehicle, Class N1 vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, invalid carriage and motor cycle;
- (iii) Article 6 a disabled person's vehicle or a vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.
- "Police operational vehicle" means any exempt vehicle under Section 5 of and Article 3A of Schedule 2 to the Vehicles Excise and Registration Act 1994.
- "Postal packets" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.
- "Public service vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 1(1) of Part I of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.
- "Relevant position" in relation to a disabled person's badge has the same meaning as in Regulation 12 of the Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 and the 2000 Regulations
- "Relevant position" in relation to a parking disc means:-
- the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the motor vehicle; or
- (ii) where the motor vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the motor vehicle
- (iii) so that the period during which waiting began is clearly legible from the outside of the motor vehicle.
- "Resident" means in relation to a parking place any person whose usual residence is at premises the postal address of which is as defined opposite to that parking place in Column 2 of the Eighth Schedule
- "Return prohibition period" means in relation to:-
- (i) Article 3.3.2 the period specified in Column 3 of the Seventh Schedule
- (ii) Article 6.5 the period specified in Column 3 of the Tenth Schedule.
- "School bus" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry twelve or more passengers and being used to carry persons to or from school.
- "Specific parking permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 5.15.

- **"Subordinate legislation"** has the same meaning as in Section 21 of the Interpretation Act 1978
- "Telecommunications apparatus" has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- "Traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, Section 64 of the Act.
- "Universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.
- "Works bus" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry twelve or more passengers which has been provided by an employer for the purpose of carrying persons employed by him to or from their place of employment and being used for that purpose.
- "The 2000 Regulations" means the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.
- "The 2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- "The 2004 Act" means the Traffic Management Act 2004.
- "The General Regulations" means the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.

PART II

3. PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS ON WAITING/LOADING AND UNLOADING

- 3.1. Save as provided in Articles 3.9, 3.10 and 3.11 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule.
- 3.2. Save as provided in Articles 3.9, 3.10 and 3.11 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in columns 1 and 2 of the Fourth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in column 3 of the Fourth Schedule unless such day falls upon a Bank Holiday.
- 3.3. Save as provided in Articles 3.9 and 3.11 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Seventh Schedule on the days and during the times specified in Column 2 of the Seventh Schedule unless such day falls upon a Bank Holiday:-
 - 3.3.1. for a period in excess of that specified in Column 3 of the Seventh Schedule; or
 - 3.3.2. if a period less than the return prohibition period has elapsed since the termination during the limited waiting hours of the last period of waiting of the motor vehicle in the same length of road.

- 3.4. Save as provided in Article 3.9 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to load or unload at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Second Schedule.
- 3.5. Save as provided in Article 3.9 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait or load or unload at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Third Schedule.
- 3.6. Save as provided in Article 3.9 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Fifth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in Column 3 of the Fifth Schedule.
- 3.7. Save as provided in Articles 3.9 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait or to load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in columns 1 and 2 of the Sixth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in column 3 of the Sixth Schedule.
- 3.8. Save as provided in Articles 3.9, 3.10 and 3.11 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 5 tonnes to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in columns 1 and 2 of the Sixteenth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in column 3 of the Sixteenth Schedule unless such day falls upon a Bank Holiday.
- 3.9. Nothing in Articles 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 3.5, 3.6, 3.7 and 3.8 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle, or in the case of Article 3.8 any motor vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 5 tonnes, to wait in a length of road specified in the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh or Sixteenth Schedules for so long as may be necessary:-
 - 3.9.1. to enable a person to board or alight from the motor vehicle;
 - 3.9.2. to enable the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any wedding or funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so specified or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
 - 3.9.3. if the motor vehicle is a Mobile Speed Camera Unit or an Automatic Number Plate Recognition Vehicle
 - 3.9.4. to enable the motor vehicle, if it is in the service of the Post Office or other universal service provider to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;

- 3.9.5. to enable the motor vehicle to be used in the length of road so specified for police, ambulance, fire and rescue, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- 3.9.6. if the motor vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the control of the driver, or to such waiting as is necessary to prevent an accident;
- 3.9.7. for the purpose of loading or unloading the motor vehicle whilst it is in actual use in connection with the removal or delivery of furniture to or from any premises fronting, adjoining or abutting the said length of road, provided that notice is given twenty four hours in advance to the Police and their consent obtained;
- 3.9.8. for a hackney carriage to wait at a hackney carriage stand during the hours of operation of the hackney carriage stand.
- 3.10. Nothing in Articles 3.1, 3.2, and 3.8 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle, or in the case of Article 3.8 any motor vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 5 tonnes, to wait in the lengths of road specified in the First, Third, Fourth and Sixteenth Schedules for so long as may be necessary to deliver to or collect from or load or unload goods at any premises fronting onto the said length of road provided that no motor vehicle so engaged shall wait for longer than 30 minutes outside the same premises without the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer and provided always that a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may at any time require the driver of a motor vehicle to move it if it is necessary for the purposes of preventing obstruction.
- 3.11. Nothing in Articles 3.1, 3.2 and 3.3, shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle, or in the case of Article 3.8 any motor vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 5 tonnes, to wait:-
 - 3.11.1. for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from the previous period of waiting by the same motor vehicle in the same road or part of road on the same day) in any of the lengths of road specified in the First, Fourth, or Sixteenth Schedules;
 - 3.11.2. in any of the lengths of road specified in the Seventh Schedule;

if the motor vehicle is a disabled person's motor vehicle which displays in the relevant positions:-

- (a) In all cases a disabled person's badge, and
- (b) In the cases referred to in Article 3.11.1. a parking disc issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the 2000 Regulations, or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge, and the driver or other person in charge of the motor vehicle marks on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting began.

PART III

4. PARKING IN LOADING BAYS

- 4.1. The part of road specified in Column 1 of the Ninth Schedule is authorised to be used as a parking place for the parking of permitted motor vehicles in the authorised position on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to the part of road in the said Schedule.
- 4.2. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place unless it is a permitted motor vehicle.
- 4.3. Every motor vehicle using the parking place shall wait thereon in the authorised position.
- 4.4. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in Column 3 of the Ninth Schedule in relation to that parking place.
- 4.5. Save as provided in Article 4.11 the driver of a motor vehicle other than a permitted motor vehicle shall not use the parking place unless authorised to do so by a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, always provided that no motor vehicle shall use the parking place so as unreasonably to prevent access to premises adjoining the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance and provided always that a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may at any time require the driver of the motor vehicle to move it if it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction or in the case of an emergency move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit, any motor vehicle left in a parking place.
- 4.6. The driver of a motor vehicle shall stop the engine as soon as the motor vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the motor vehicle in or to depart from, the parking place.
- 4.7. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for any purpose other than when in actual use in connection with the delivery to or collection from or loading or unloading of goods to nearby premises.
- 4.8. A person authorised by the enforcement authority may suspend the use of the parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary;
 - 4.8.1. for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - 4.8.2. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from a dwellinghouse or office to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - 4.8.3. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions;
 - 4.8.4. for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying,

- erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
- 4.8.5. and he has made an appropriate Order and/or given notice as may be required by legislation.
- 4.9. A person authorised by the enforcement authority suspending the use of the parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Article 4.8 shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign or notice indicating that waiting by motor vehicles is prohibited.
- 4.10. Save as provided in Articles 4.8 and 4.9 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in the parking place or part thereof, as the case may be, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof a traffic sign or notice placed in pursuance of Article 4.9.
- 4.11. Nothing in Articles 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4 and 4.10 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to wait in the parking place for so long as it may be necessary:-
 - 4.11.1. to enable a person to board or alight from the motor vehicle;
 - 4.11.2. to enable the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or near the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
 - 4.11.3. to enable the motor vehicle, if it is in the service of the Post Office or other universal service provider to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
 - 4.11.4. to enable the motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 4.11.5. if the motor vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstance beyond the control of the driver, or to prevent an accident;
 - 4.11.6. to enable the motor vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from a dwellinghouse or office to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
- 4.12. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a motor vehicle is left in the parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4 and 4.10 a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may remove the motor vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place provided that when a motor vehicle is waiting in the parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 4.3, a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.

- 4.13. Any person removing a motor vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 4.12 may do so by towing or driving the motor vehicle or such other manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- 4.14. When a person authorised by the enforcement authority removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a motor vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 4.12, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the motor vehicle and its contents

PART IV

5. PARKING PLACES – PERMIT HOLDERS

- 5.1. The part of road specified in Column 1 of the Eighth Schedule is authorised to be used as a parking place for the parking of permitted motor vehicles in the authorised position and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to the said part of road in Column 3 of the Eighth Schedule. A permit holder may only park in any of the parking places provided that they are of a category authorised to use the parking place which is specified directly opposite thereto in Column 2 of the Eighth Schedule.
- 5.2. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place unless it is a permitted motor vehicle.
- 5.3. Every motor vehicle using the parking place shall wait thereon in the authorised position.
- 5.4. Save as provided in Articles 5.10 and 5.11 the driver of a motor vehicle other than a permitted motor vehicle shall not use the parking place unless authorised to do so by a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, always provided that no motor vehicle shall use the parking place so as unreasonably to prevent access to premises adjoining the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance and provided always that a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may at any time require the driver of the motor vehicle to move it if it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction or in the case of an emergency move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit, any motor vehicle left in a parking place.
- 5.5. The driver of a motor vehicle shall stop the engine as soon as the motor vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change position of the motor vehicle in, or to depart from, the parking place.
- 5.6. No person shall use a motor vehicle, whilst it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services or any other person's skill or services.
- 5.7. A person authorised by the enforcement authority may suspend the use of the parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-
 - 5.7.1. for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - 5.7.2. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from a dwelling, house or office to another

- or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- 5.7.3. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions;
- 5.7.4. for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
- 5.7.5. and he has made an appropriate Order and/or given notice as may be required by legislation.
- 5.8. A person authorised by the enforcement authority suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Article 5.7 shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign or notice indicating that waiting by motor vehicles is prohibited.
- 5.9. Save as provided in Articles 5.10 and 5.11 no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be left in the parking place or part thereof, as the case may be, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof a traffic sign or notice in pursuance of Article 5.8.
- 5.10. Nothing in Articles 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.9 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to wait in the parking place for so long as it may be necessary:-
 - 5.10.1. to enable a person to board or alight from the motor vehicle;
 - 5.10.2. to enable the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or any part thereof of the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or near the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of and telecommunications apparatus;
 - 5.10.3. to enable the motor vehicle, if it is in the service of the Post Office or other universal service provider to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets:
 - 5.10.4. to enable the motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 5.10.5. if the motor vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstance beyond the control of the driver, or to prevent an accident;
 - 5.10.6. to enable the motor vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from a dwellinghouse or office to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.

- 5.11. Nothing in Articles 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.9 shall apply if the motor vehicle is being used by a legally qualified general medical practitioner, district nurse, midwife or similar people when visiting persons whose postal address is as defined opposite to that parking place in Column 2 of the Eighth Schedule, so long as the motor vehicle concerned is clearly marked Doctor, Midwife etc. and the visit is expected to be of less than 15 minutes duration.
- 5.12. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a motor vehicle is left in the parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.9 a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may remove the motor vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place provided that when a motor vehicle is waiting in the parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 5.3, a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may alter or cause to be altered the position of the motor vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 5.13. Any person removing a motor vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 5.12 may do so by towing or driving the motor vehicle or such other manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- 5.14. When a person authorised by the enforcement authority removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a motor vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 5.12, he shall make such arrangement as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the motor vehicle and its contents.

Application for and issue of permits

- 5.15. Any resident who is the owner of a permitted motor vehicle may apply to the enforcement authority for the issue of a specific parking permit for the leaving of that motor vehicle in a parking place and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the enforcement authority and shall include the particulars and information required by such form.
- 5.16. On receipt of an application for a specific parking permit duly made under the foregoing provisions of Article 5.15, the enforcement authority, upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a permitted motor vehicle, may, subject to the proviso hereto, and upon payment of the administration charge being such sum as may be determined by the enforcement authority, issue to the applicant one permit for the leaving in the parking place of the motor vehicle to which such permit related by the owner of such motor vehicle or by any person using such motor vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such motor vehicle has been let for hire or reward provided that subject to the provisions of Article 5.24 and 5.25, the enforcement authority shall not issue a permit to any resident which would be valid any period during which any other permit issued to that resident is or would be valid.
- 5.17. Any resident may apply to the enforcement authority for the issue of a an open or two open parking permit(s) to enable a bona vide visitor to his premises to leave a permitted motor vehicle in a parking place and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the enforcement authority and shall include the particulars and information required by such form. Subject to Article 5.20 a maximum of two open parking permits may be issued to the residents of premises having a separate postal address.

- "5.17A "A second open parking permit will be issued by the enforcement authority only upon receipt of the administration charge being such sum as may be determined by the enforcement authority"
- 5.18. Any occupant of business premises may, after payment of such charge as may be determined by the enforcement authority, apply to the enforcement authority for the issue or renewal of a business parking permit (which shall be valid for a period of twelve months from the date of issue or renewal or such lesser period as the enforcement authority may determine) for the leaving of a permitted motor vehicle in a parking place.
 - "5.18A Where a vehicle is to be used in connection with works being undertaken at premises in relation to which a specific parking permit has been or could be issued under Article 5.16, use should, wherever possible, be made of any open parking permit issued in relation to those premises. Where that is not possible, the driver or owner of the vehicle must apply to the enforcement authority for the grant of a business parking permit for the leaving of that motor vehicle in a parking place."
- 5.19. The enforcement authority may at any time require a permit holder or applicant for a permit to produce to an officer of the enforcement authority such evidence in respect of an application made to them for a permit as they may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them.
- 5.20. The enforcement authority may at their discretion issue a permit with or without charge to any person who in the opinion of the enforcement authority requires to park in any parking place any permitted motor vehicle.
 - "5.20A. Where the council elects to make a charge for the issue of a permit such charge shall be in accordance with the scale of charges which appears in the Fifteenth Schedule or in accordance with such revised scale as may be introduced by means of a further order or by a notice of variation under Section 46A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984"
- 5.21. The issue of a permit under the foregoing provisions of Article 5.16, 5.17, 5.17A, 5.18 and 5.18A shall not be construed as if any parking space in the parking place was reserved solely for the use of a permit holder.

Surrender, withdrawal and validity of permits

- 5.22. A permit holder may surrender a permit to the enforcement authority at any time and shall surrender a permit to the enforcement authority on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in Article 5.25.
- 5.23. The enforcement authority may, by notice in writing served on the permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the permit holder at the address shown by that person on the application for the permit or at any address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a permit entirely at its own discretion and the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the enforcement authority with 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.

5.24. A permit shall cease to be valid on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in Article 5.25. 5.25. The events referred to in Article 5.22 are:-5.25.1. the permit holder ceasing to be a resident; 5.25.2. the permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the motor vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued; 5.25.3. the withdrawal of such permit by the enforcement authority under the provisions of Article 5.23; 5.25.4. the motor vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is no longer a permitted motor vehicle. 5.25.5. "the permit was issued on the basis that it would continue in force provided a renewal fee was paid but such fee has not been paid." Application for and issue of duplicate permits If a permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have 5.26. become illegible or the colour of the permit has become altered by fading or otherwise the permit holder shall surrender it to the enforcement authority and the enforcement authority, upon receipt of the permit, shall issue a duplicate permit so marked. 5.27. If the permit is lost or destroyed, the permit holder may apply to the enforcement authority for the issue to him of a duplicate permit and the enforcement authority, upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction, shall issue a duplicate permit so marked and upon such issue the permit which it duplicates shall become invalid provided that a replacement for a duplicate permit will only be issued upon payment of a charge (being such sum as the enforcement authority may from time to time determine). 5.28. the provisions of the Order shall apply to a duplicate permit and an application therefor as if it were a permit or as the case may be an application therefor. Form of permit 5.29. A permit shall be in writing and shall bear the words "Specific Permit", "Open Permit" or "Business Permit" or such other title as may be determined by the enforcement authority" as the case may be and shall include the following particulars:-5.29.1. the registration mark of the motor vehicle in respect of which the permit has been issued 5.29.2. the name of the road or roads or district in which the parking place is situate and for which the permit is issued; 5.29.3. an authentication that the permit has been issued by the enforcement authority;

- 5.29A a permit shall be valid until any date specified on the face of the permit but in any case where no date is so specified until such time as one of the following events occurs;
- 5.29A.1 the permit holder ceases to be a resident;
- 5.29A.2 the permit holder ceases to be the owner of the motor vehicle for which the permit has been issued;
- 5.29A.3 the permit holder makes a Statutory Off Road Notification (SORN) to the DVLA;
- 5.29A.4 any required payment for the permit has been cancelled by the payer;
- 5.29A.5 any other event at the discretion of the enforcement authority such as misuse of the permit in which case the enforcement authority shall write to the permit holder informing them of the cancellation of the permit."

Display of permits

5.30. At all times during which a motor vehicle is left in a parking place there shall be displayed on the front or near side of the motor vehicle a valid permit issued in respect of that motor vehicle so that all particulars referred to in Article 5.29 are readily visible from the front or near side or the motor vehicle.

Restriction on the removal of permits

5.31. When a permit has been displayed on a motor vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5.30, no person not being the driver of the motor vehicle shall remove the permit from the motor vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the motor vehicle.

PART V

6. DISABLED BAYS

- 6.1. The part of road specified in Column 1 of the Tenth Schedule is authorised to be used as a parking place for the parking of permitted motor vehicles in the authorised position on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to the part of road in the said Tenth Schedule.
- 6.2. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place unless it is a permitted motor vehicle.
- 6.3. Every motor vehicle using the parking place shall wait thereon in the authorised position.
- 6.4. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in Column 3 of the Tenth Schedule in relation to that parking place.
- 6.5. When a motor vehicle has left a parking place as specified in Article 6.1 after waiting thereon, the driver thereof shall not, within the return prohibition period specified in column 3 of the Tenth Schedule permit it to wait again upon the parking place.

- 6.6. Save as provided in Articles 6.12 and 6.13 the driver of a motor vehicle other than a permitted motor vehicle shall not use the parking place unless authorised to do so by a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, always provided that no motor vehicle shall use the parking place so as unreasonably to prevent access to premises adjoining the road or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance and provided always that a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may at any time require the driver of the motor vehicle to move it if it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction or in the case of an emergency move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit, any motor vehicle left in a parking place.
- 6.7. The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the motor vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the motor vehicle in, or to depart from, the parking place.
- 6.8. No person shall use a motor vehicle whilst it is in the parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services or any other person's skills or services.
- 6.9. Any person duly authorised by the enforcement authority may suspend the use of the parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary;
 - 6.9.1. or the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - 6.9.2. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from a dwellinghouse or office to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - 6.9.3. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions;
 - 6.9.4. for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
 - 6.9.5. and he has made an appropriate Order and/or given notice as may be required by legislation.
- 6.10. Any person authorised by the enforcement authority suspending the use of the parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Article 6.9 shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign or notice indicating that waiting by motor vehicles is prohibited.
- 6.11. Save as provided in Articles 6.12 and 6.13 no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be left in the parking place or part thereof, as the case may be, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof a traffic sign or notice placed in pursuance of Article 6.10

- 6.12. Nothing in Articles 6.1, 6.6 and 6.11 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to wait in the parking place for so long as it may be necessary:-
 - 6.12.1. to enable a person to board or alight from the motor vehicle;
 - 6.12.2. to enable the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or near the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
 - 6.12.3. to enable the motor vehicle, if it is in the service of the Post Office or other universal service provider to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
 - 6.12.4. to enable the motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 6.12.5. if the motor vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstance beyond the control of the driver, or to prevent an accident;
 - 6.12.6. to enable the motor vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from a dwellinghouse or office to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
- 6.13. Nothing Articles 6.1, 6.6 and 6.11 shall apply if the motor vehicle is being used by a legally qualified general medical practitioner, district nurse, midwife, or similar people when visiting a patient, so long as the motor vehicle concerned is clearly marked doctor/midwife etc. and the visit is expected to be of less than 15 minutes duration.
- 6.14. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a motor vehicle is left in the parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 6.1, 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4 a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may remove the motor vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place provided that when a motor vehicle is waiting in the parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 6.3, a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may alter or cause to be altered the position of the motor vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 6.15. Any person removing a motor vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 6.14 may do so by towing or driving the motor vehicle or such other manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- 6.16. When a person authorised by the enforcement authority removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a motor vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 6.14, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the motor vehicle and its contents.

PART VI

7. SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR – NO WAITING, LOADING OR UNLOADING

- 7.1. Save as provided in Article 7.2 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait, load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in columns 1 and 2 of the Eleventh Schedule on the days and during the times specified in column 3 of the Eleventh Schedule.
- 7.2. Nothing in Article 7.1 shall apply: -
 - 7.2.1. so as to prevent a motor vehicle waiting in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable the motor vehicle to be used in connection with: -
 - 7.2.1.1. any building operation or demolition;
 - 7.2.1.2. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - 7.2.1.3. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road comprising or including the carriageway; or
 - 7.2.1.4. the laying erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of a sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus.
 - 7.2.2. to a motor vehicle being used for fire and rescue, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 7.2.3. to a motor vehicle being used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 7.2.4. to a motor vehicle waiting in any of the lengths of road referred to in Article 7.1 while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the motor vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the motor vehicle to wait otherwise than on that length of road; or
 - 7.2.5. to a motor vehicle waiting when the person in control of the motor vehicle:-
 - 7.2.5.1. is required by law to stop;
 - 7.2.5.2. is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident; or
 - 7.2.5.3. is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond that person's control.

PART VII

8. BUS LANES

- 8.1. Save as provided in Article 8.4 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle other than a public service vehicle, school bus, works bus, omnibus or pedal cycle to wait at any time in any of the bus lanes specified in columns 1 and 2 of the Twelfth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in column 3 of the Twelfth Schedule other than for the purpose of crossing it.
- 8.2. In relation to the bus lanes specified at items 9a and 9b, 11, 12 and 13 in the Twelfth Schedule the list of exempted vehicles which appears in Article 8.1 shall include hackney carriages, ambulances and those vehicles carrying patients on behalf of the Yorkshire Ambulance Service as are displaying approved door mounted ambulance plates.
- 8.3. In relation to the bus lane specified at item 7 in the Twelfth Schedule the list of exempted vehicles which appears in Article 8.1 shall include abnormal indivisible load vehicles and abnormal indivisible load vehicle escort vehicles.
- 8.4. Nothing in Articles 8.1, 8.2 or 8.3 shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait in the bus lane for so long as may be necessary for any of the purposes specified in Article 8.5.
- 8.5. The purposes referred to in Article 8.4 are:
 - 8.5.1. the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the bus lane;
 - 8.5.2. police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
- 8.6. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait in the bus lane for so long as may be necessary for any of the purposes specified in Article 8.7.
- 8.7. The purposes referred to in Article 8.6 are: -
 - 8.7.1. the service of any local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, or to be used in connection with the supply of gas, or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus.
 - 8.7.2. the avoidance of an accident
 - 8.7.3. the boarding or alighting of any person.

PART VIII

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- 9.1. Save as provided in Article 9.2 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait on any of the main carriageways comprised of the lengths of road specified in Columns 1 and 2 of the Thirteenth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in Column 3 of the Thirteenth Schedule.
- 9.2. Nothing in Article 9.1 shall apply:-
 - 9.2.1. so as to prevent the motor vehicle waiting on the carriageway of a road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable the motor vehicle to be used in connection with:-
 - 9.2.1.1. any building operation or demolition;
 - 9.2.1.2. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - 9.2.1.3. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road comprising or including that carriageway; or
 - 9.2.1.4. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of a sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus.
 - 9.2.2. to a motor vehicle being used for fire and rescue, ambulance or police purposes, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 9.2.3. to a motor vehicle being used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - 9.2.4. to a motor vehicle being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
 - 9.2.5. to a motor vehicle waiting in the carriageway referred to in that Article while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the motor vehicle requires access or form which it has emerged is opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the motor vehicle to wait otherwise than on that carriageway; or
 - 9.2.6. to a motor vehicle waiting when the person in control of the motor vehicle:-
 - 9.2.6.1. is required by law to stop;
 - 9.2.6.2. is obliged to stop in order to avoid and accident; or
 - 9.2.6.3. is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond that person's control.

PART IX

10. CYCLE LANES

- 10.1. Save as provided in Articles 10.2 and 10.3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle other than a pedal cycle to wait in a cycle lane specified in the Fourteenth Schedule on the days and during the times specified in Column 3 of the Fourteenth Schedule.
- 10.2. Nothing in Article 10.1 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to wait in a cycle lane specified in the Fourteenth Schedule for so long as may be necessary:
 - 10.2.1. to be used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - 10.2.2. to be used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes;
 - 10.2.3. to be used in the service of any local authority or water authority or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that whilst being so used it is necessary for the motor vehicle to wait in the cycle lane;
 - 10.2.4. to avoid an accident;
 - 10.2.5. to gain entrance to premises or land accessible only by crossing the cycle lane or to off-street loading facilities or garaging;
 - 10.2.6. for public service vehicles at a bus stop area.
- 10.3. Nothing in Article 10.1 shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle or gully emptying machine or to do anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

PART X

11. PARKING IN POLICE BAYS

- 11.1. That part of road specified in Column 1 of the Fifteenth Schedule is authorised to be used as a parking place for the parking of permitted motor vehicles in the authorised position on such days and during such times as are specified in relation to the part of road in Column 3 of the said Schedule.
- 11.2. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place unless it is a permitted motor vehicle.
- 11.3. Every motor vehicle using the parking place shall wait thereon in the authorised position.
- 11.4. Save as provided in Article 11.8 the driver of a motor vehicle other than a permitted vehicle shall not use the parking place unless authorised to do so by a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, always provided that no motor vehicle shall use the parking place so as unreasonably to prevent access to premises adjoining the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance and provided always that a police constable in uniform or a civil

enforcement officer may at any time require the driver of the motor vehicle to move it if it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction or in the case of an emergency move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit, any motor vehicle left in a parking place.

- 11.5. A person authorised by the enforcement authority may suspend the use of the parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary;
 - 11.5.1. for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety
 - 11.5.2. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from a dwelling house or office to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
 - 11.5.3. for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
- 11.6. A person authorised by the enforcement authority suspending the use of the parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Article 11.5 shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof the use of which is to be suspended a traffic sign or notice indicating that the waiting of motor vehicles is prohibited.
- 11.7. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be left in the parking place or part thereof, as the case may be, during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part thereof a traffic sign or notice placed in pursuance of Article 11.6 unless the vehicle is waiting for a purpose specified in Article 11.5.2 or 11.5.3.
- 11.8. Nothing in Articles 11.1, 11.2, 11.3 and 11.7 shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any motor vehicle to wait in the parking place for so long as it may be necessary:-
 - 11.8.1. to enable a person to board or alight from a motor vehicle;
 - 11.8.2. to enable the motor vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or near the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus.
 - 11.8.3. to enable the motor vehicle, if it is in the service of the Post Office or other universal service provider, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
 - 11.8.4. to enable the motor vehicle to be used for ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- 11.8.5. if the motor vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the control of the driver, or to prevent an accident;
- 11.8.6. to enable the motor vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
- 11.9. Subject to the provision hereto, when a motor vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 11.1, 11.2, 11.3 and 11.7 a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may remove the motor vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place provided that when a motor vehicle is waiting in the parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 11.3, a person authorised in that behalf by the enforcement authority may alter or cause to be altered the position of the motor vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- 11.10. Any person removing a motor vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Article 11.9 may do so by towing or driving the motor vehicle or such other manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- 11.11. When a person authorised by the enforcement authority removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a motor vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 11.10, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonable necessary for the safe custody of the motor vehicle and its contents.

PART XI

12. PARKING FOR CAR CLUB VEHICLES

- 12.1. The part of road in Huddersfield which is described as a parking place in Column 2 of the Seventeenth Schedule is hereby designated as a car club parking place.
- 12.2. The car club parking place shall have within its length not more than the maximum number of parking bays specified in Column 3 of the Seventeenth Schedule.
- 12.3. Subject to the maximum number the number and disposition of such parking bays in the car club parking place shall be determined from time to time by the Council.
- 12.4. The car club parking place may be used subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving of car club vehicles.
- 12.5. The limits of the car club parking place and each parking bay shall be indicated by the appropriate traffic signs or road markings for which special authorisation has been granted by the Department for Transport.
- 12.6. Every car club vehicle left in a parking bay shall so stand so that the vehicle is wholly within the limits of the parking bay.
- 12.7. Where any car club vehicle is standing in a parking bay in contravention of the provisions of Article 12.6 a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

- 12.8. Where a police constable in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking bay she/he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking bay.
- 12.9. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Articles 12.7, 12.8 or 12.11 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as she/he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as she/he may think necessary to enable him/her to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.
- 12.10. When a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking bay she/he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- 12.11. A police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer may in the case of emergency move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit a vehicle left in a parking bay.
- 12.12. A police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer may suspend the use of a parking bay whenever she/he considers such suspension reasonably necessary always provided that adequate prior notice has been received:
 - 12.12.1. for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety
 - 12.12.2. for the purpose of any building engineering or construction operation demolition or excavation adjacent to or in the parking bay
 - 12.12.3. for the purpose of maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the parking bay or the laying erection alteration or repair in or near the parking bay or car club parking place of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984 or of any traffic sign
 - 12.12.4. for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking bay on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository
 - 12.12.5. on any such occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed
 - 12.12.6. for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking bay at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions
- 12.13. A police constable in uniform or Civil Enforcement Officer may suspend for not longer than twenty four hours the use of a parking bay whenever she/he considers such suspensions reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety
- 12.14. A police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer suspending the use of a parking bay in accordance with the provisions of Articles 12.12 and 12.13 of this Order shall thereupon place or cause to be placed upon the relevant part of the parking bay traffic cones

- (as described in the current Traffic Signs Regulations & General Directions) or such other traffic cones or lights as are appropriate to indicate that waiting by vehicles is prohibited
- 12.15. Subject to the provision contained herein no person shall cause or permit any car club vehicle to be left in a parking bay during such period as there is a notice traffic cone sign or light placed within the parking bay in pursuance of Article 12.14 of this Order **PROVIDED THAT** nothing in this Article shall apply to:
 - 12.15.1. any vehicle being used for Fire Brigade Ambulance or Police purposes or any Local Authority purpose or for any purpose specified in Article 12.12.1
 - 12.15.2. any other vehicle if that vehicle is so left with the permission of the person who authorised the suspension of use of the parking bay in accordance with the forgoing provisions of this Article
- 12.16. Unless prior written consent has been granted by the Council no person shall:
 - 12.16.1. use a car club vehicle while it is in a parking bay in connection with the sale or advertisement of anything to persons in or near the parking bay or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services
 - 12.16.2. use any part of a parking bay with any building structure mechanical device or other physical feature therein or any car club vehicle left therein to display advertising material nor to place upon or attach to any car club vehicle in the parking bay any advertising material to induce the public to participate in or frequent any place function or gathering for the purpose of demonstration or entertainment or to buy or hire or otherwise obtain anything or the skill or services of any person and nothing shall be displayed to induce the public to engage for gain in any lottery raffle or competition
- 12.17. Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order with respect to car club vehicles which are left in a parking bay in accordance with those provisions any other vehicle may wait in a parking bay if:
 - 12.17.1. the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle
 - 12.17.2. the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such other waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident
 - 12.17.3. the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance or a vehicle in the service of a local authority or a vehicle in the service of a police force in such cases being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - 12.17.4. the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction of traffic
 - 12.17.5. the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any of the purposes specified in Article 12.12.2 to 12.12.6 and the use of the vehicle for any such purpose or the amount of time during which

the vehicle will remain in the parking bay for that purpose does not in the opinion of the Council warrant the suspension of use of the parking bay

12.18. A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking bay by virtue of Article 12.17 shall take all necessary steps to ensure that the vehicle is left in accordance with Article 12.6

PART XII

13. GENERAL

- 13.1. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 13.2. Any reference in this Order to a Statute or Statutory Instrument shall include reference to any re-enactment or replacement thereof
- 13.3. For the avoidance of doubt, any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road or more than one parking place where the context requires it.
- 13.4. Where the provisions of this Order or any Order made or having effect as if made under the Act which impose any restriction or prohibition on waiting by motor vehicles, or grant any exemption from such restriction or prohibition, relate to a road or length of road designated as a parking place in the Eighth, Ninth and Tenth Schedules the provisions of the said Schedules shall prevail.
- 13.5. For the avoidance of doubt this Order is deemed to be a designation order for the purpose of charging for the issue or replacement as appropriate of a permit under the provisions of Part IV of this Order.
- 13.6. For the further avoidance of doubt the revocation of any Order referred to in the Eighteenth Schedule to this Order is not intended to reverse any revocation made by or otherwise referred to in that Order.
- 13.7. Where the council deem it so expedient all references to "permit" in this Order shall include reference to "Specific Permit", "Business Permit" and "Open Permit" or such other title as may be determined by the enforcement authority and permit holder shall be similarly construed.
- 13.8. In this Order when the context requires, the masculine includes the feminine and the neuter and vice versa, the singular includes the plural and vice versa.

PART XIII

14. CONTRAVENTIONS OF PROVISIONS OF ORDER

14.1. Where a motor vehicle is left in a parking place or in any road or length of road in contravention of any provision of this Order such contravention shall be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the 2004 Act and any subordinate legislation made under it.

14.2. The amount of the penalty charge for a parking contravention and, where applicable, the charges for the removal, storage and disposal of a vehicle shall be as set from time to time by the enforcement authority in accordance with the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (England) Order 2007 or any re-enactment or replacement thereof and published by it.
