

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.6) ORDER 2021**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order which relates to roads in Huddersfield in the Kirklees District:-

PART 1: GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

1.1 This Order shall come into operation on the 23 September 2022 and may be cited as "Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No.6) Order 2021".

1.2 This Order is made in accordance with Regulation 23 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and is made for the sole purpose of making permanent the provisions of the Kirklees Council (Traffic Regulation) (No.6) (Experimental) Order 2021, dated 23 March 2021.

PART 2: INTERPRETATION

2.1 Any reference in this Order to a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Schedule bearing that number in this Order and a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.

2.2 In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

"local bus" means a public service vehicle which is being operated for the purposes of a local service within the meaning of the Transport Act 1985.

"security vehicle" means any specialist security vehicle loading or unloading valuables

“telecommunications apparatus” has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984

“the 2002 Regulations” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002

**PART 3: PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES)
BETWEEN THE HOURS OF**

**4:30pm – 7am in November – February; and
7pm – 7am in March – May; and
9pm – 7am in June – August; and
7pm – 7am in September– October**

3.1 Save as provided in Articles 3.1, 3.2 and 3.3 no vehicle other than vehicles authorised by the enforcement authority’s Parking Manager, shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer proceed in any of those lengths of road specified in the Schedule between the hours and at the times specified in the Schedule

3.2 Nothing in Article 3.1 shall render it unlawful for any vehicle to enter or proceed in any of the lengths of road referred to therein to enable the vehicle to be used for any of the purposes specified in Article 3.3 for so long as may be necessary for any of those purposes.

3.3 The purposes referred to in Article 3.2 are:-

- (i) in an emergency where the vehicle is being used for police, fire and rescue, ambulance or local authority purposes;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) in connection with any of the following operations where the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road:-
 - (a) building, industrial or demolition operations;

- (b) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
- (c) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on any land adjacent to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus.

PART 4: GENERAL

4.1. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

4.2. Any reference in this Order to a Statute or Statutory Instrument shall include reference to any re-enactment or replacement thereof.

4.3. For the avoidance of doubt, any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road or more than one parking place where the context requires it.
