ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHAPEL BROW, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION, PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

The County Council of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. <u>Definitions and Interpretation</u>

For all the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:

"Vehicle" means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motorcycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power.

2. Revocation

Those parts of the "South Ribble Borough Council (Chapel Brow and Associated Streets, Leyland) (Revocation, One-Way, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Restriction of Loading/Unloading, Loading and Disabled Parking Bay) Order 2004", as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order, are hereby revoked.

3. Prohibition of Right Turn

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any Vehicle, to turn right at the Junction set out in Schedule 2 to this Order.

4. One Way Traffic Restriction

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, to enter or proceed along the length of road set out in Schedule 3 to this Order, in any direction other than that specified.

5. Exemptions

Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to travel along any part of the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:

- a) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- the vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;
- c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection the removal of any obstruction to traffic.

6. Miscellaneous

The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

7. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of January 2023 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Chapel Brow, Leyland, South Ribble Borough) (Revocation, Prohibition Of Right Turn And One Way Traffic) Order 2023"

Schedule 1 - Revocation

Schedule 4 insofar as it relates to, Chapel Brow, from its junction with Churchill Way to its junction with Golden Hill Lane.

Schedule 2 - Prohibition Of Right Turn

Chapel Brow, Leyland, vehicles on Chapel Brow to be prohibited from turning right onto Station Brow.

Schedule 3 - One Way Traffic
Chapel Brow, Leyland, from its junction with Fleetwood Street to its junction with Golden Hill Lane/Station Brow (south to north).
