ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COASTAL ROAD, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY) (REVOCATION AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under 83(2) and Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Revocation

- a) "The County Council of Lancashire (Morecambe Coastal Road, A.5105, Hest Bank) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1961" is hereby revoked in full.
- b) "The County Council of Lancaster (40 m.p.h Speed Limit Direction) (No. 6) Order, 1962" is hereby revoked in full.

2. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

3. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

4. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 20th day of January 2023 and shall be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Coastal Road, Morecambe, Lancaster City) (Revocation And 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2023".
