THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT) (NO 1) ORDER 2009

The City Council of Lancaster (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the County Council of Lancashire in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 33, 34, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 63A and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(hereinafter called the "1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and Section 43 and Schedules 3 and 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1991(hereinafter called the "1991 Act") hereby make the following order.

1. Commencement, Citation and Revocation

1.1 This Order shall come into operation on 6 April 2009 and may be cited as "The City Council of Lancaster (Off Street Parking Places)(Amendment) (No 1) Order, 2009".

2. Interpretations

2.1 Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

2.2 In this order, except where the context otherwise, requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them: -

2.2.1 "1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2.2.2 "Enactment" - means any enactment, whether public, general, or local and includes any order, bylaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

2.3 Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or substituted by any subsequent enactment.

2.4 Any reference in this order to a masculine gender shall include reference to the feminine gender and neuter gender.

2.5 Any reference in this Order to a singular includes the plural.

2.6 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Amendments

3.1 The City Council of Lancaster (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2008, the Principal Order, is hereby amended as follows:

(1) The definition of "General Permits" in Article 26 of the Principal Order is hereby removed and replaced by:

"26. (1) General Permits and General (5 day) Permits - Any person who is the

registered keeper of vehicle of a class authorised to use a parking place may apply to the Council for the issue of a General or General (5 day) Permit for the parking of that vehicle in the relevant parking place or parking places as specified in the Schedule. The application shall be accompanied by a remittance of the charge stated in the Schedule."

- (2) The definition of "Morecambe General Permits" in Article 26 of the Principal Order is hereby removed and replaced by:

"26. (2) Morecambe General Permits and Morecambe General (5 day) Permits - Any person who is the registered keeper of vehicle of a class authorised to use a parking place may apply to the Council for the issue of a Morecambe General or Morecambe General (5 day) Permit for the parking of that vehicle in the relevant parking place or parking places as specified in the Schedule. The application shall be accompanied by a remittance of the charge stated in the Schedule."

- (3) The definition of "Specific Permits" in Article 27 of the Principal Order is hereby removed and replaced by:

"27. 2) Specific Permits and Specific (5 day) Permits - Any person who is the registered keeper of vehicle of a class authorised to use a parking place may apply to the Council for the issue of a Specific or Specific (5 day) Permit for the parking of that vehicle in the relevant parking place or parking places as specified in the Schedule. The application shall be accompanied by a remittance of the charge stated in the Schedule."

- (4) The definition of "Staff General Permits" in Article 28 of the Principal Order is hereby removed and replaced by:

"28. 3) Staff General Permits and Staff General (5 day) Permits - Any employee of the Council who is the registered keeper of vehicle of a class authorised to use a parking place may apply to the Council for the issue of a Staff or Staff (5 day) Permits for the parking of that vehicle in the relevant parking place or parking places as specified in the Schedule. The application shall be accompanied by a remittance of the charge stated in the Schedule."

- (5) The definition of "Staff Specific Permits" in Article 29 of the Principal Order is hereby removed and replaced by:

"29. 4) Staff Specific Permits and Staff Specific (5 day) Permits - Any employee of the Council who is the registered keeper of vehicle of a class authorised to use a parking place and is employed in a post designated by the Council

as being one entitling the holder to obtain a Staff Specific or Staff Specific (5 day) Permit may apply to the Council for the issue of a Staff or Staff (5 day) Permits for the parking of that vehicle in the relevant parking place as specified in the Schedule. The application shall be accompanied by a remittance of the charge stated in the Schedule."

- (6) The definition of "Member Permits" in Article 30 of the Principal Order is hereby removed and replaced by:

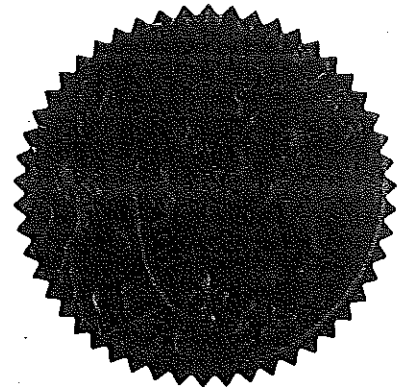
"30. 5) Member Permits and Member (5 day) Permits - Any elected member of the Council who is the registered keeper of vehicle of a class authorised to use a parking place may apply to the Council for the issue of a Member or Member (5 day) Permit for the parking of that vehicle in the relevant parking place as specified in the Schedule. The application shall be accompanied by a remittance of the charge stated in the Schedule."

The Principal Schedule and the charges specified therein are hereby amended by the attached Amendment No1 2009 schedule

The Prohibitions and Restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
