

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ACT 2004 - SECTIONS 77 AND PARTS 1 AND 3 OF SCHEDULE 9

Leeds City Council ("the Council") as civil enforcement authority for the Metropolitan District of Leeds HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that, it has set the following penalty charges for higher and lower level parking contraventions and penalty charges in relation to the removal storage and disposal of vehicles, the higher level contraventions are those listed in the Schedule and the lower level penalty charge will apply for all other parking contraventions:

Level of Penalty Charge	£70	£50
If the penalty charge is paid within 21 days of issue of penalty charge imposed on the basis of a record produced by an approved device and 14 days in all other cases	£35	£25
If the penalty charge is paid after the service of a charge certificate	£105	£75
Wheel clamping release charge:		£40
Charge in respect of vehicle removal:		£105
Charge in respect of storage of vehicle: (for each 24 hours or part thereof, that the vehicle is impounded)		£12
Charge in respect of disposal of unclaimed vehicle:		£50

The above charges will apply to the whole of the Leeds Metropolitan District and will come into force on the 1st April 2008

Schedule

- Parked in a restricted street during prescribed hours
- Parked or loading/unloading in a restricted street where waiting and loading/unloading restrictions are in force
- Parked in a residents' or shared use parking place without clearly displaying either a permit or voucher or pay and display ticket issued for that place
- Parked in an electric vehicles charging place during restricted hours without charging
- Parked in a permit space without displaying a valid permit
- Using a vehicle in a parking place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of goods when prohibited
- Parked in a loading gap marked by a yellow line
- Parked in a suspended bay/space or part of bay/space
- Parked in a parking place or area not designated for that class of vehicle
- Parked in a loading place during restricted hours without loading
- Vehicle parked more than 50 centimetres from the edge of the carriageway and not within a designated parking place
- Parked adjacent to a dropped footway
- Parked in a designated disabled person's parking place without clearly displaying a valid disabled person's badge
- Parked in a parking place designated for diplomatic vehicles
- Parked in a parking place designated for police vehicles
- Parked on a taxi rank
- Stopped where prohibited (on a red route or clearway)
- Stopped on a restricted bus stop or stand
- Stopped in a restricted area outside a school
- Parked wholly or partly on a cycle track
- A commercial vehicle parked in a restricted street in contravention of an overnight waiting ban
- Parked in contravention of a commercial vehicle waiting restriction
- Parked in contravention of a coach ban
- A heavy commercial vehicle wholly or partly parked on a footway, verge or land between two carriageways
- Parked with one or more wheels on any part of an urban road other than a carriageway (footway parking)
- Stopped on a pedestrian crossing and/or crossing area marked by zig-zags
- Parked in a loading area during restricted hours without reasonable excuse
- Using a vehicle in a parking place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of goods when prohibited
- Parked in a restricted area in a car park
- Parked in a permit bay without clearly displaying a valid permit
- Parked in a disabled person's parking space without clearly displaying a valid disabled person's badge
- Vehicle parked exceeds maximum weight and/or height and/or length permitted in the area
- Parked in a car park or area not designated for that class of vehicle
- Parked causing an obstruction
