Part 409 the layby, from its junction with Francis Street to a point 42 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 from a point 42 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 36 metres north-west of its junction with Stoughton Road

Part 207 from a point 36 metres north-west of its junction with Stoughton Road to a point 21 metres north-west of its junction with Stoughton Road

Part 207 from a point 3 metres north-west of its junction with Stoughton Road to its junction with Stoughton Road

South-west Side

Part 207 from its junction with Stoughton Road to its junction with Francis Street, excluding the limited waiting parking boxes between 82 metres and 69 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street and 63 metres and 52 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street, and the layby between 36 metres and 3 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 the limited waiting parking box, from a point 82 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 69 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 the limited waiting parking box, from a point 63 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 52 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 the layby, from a point 36 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 3 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409

Designated Pay And Display Parking Place.

No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait for more than 3 hours or to return to the same length of designated parking place restriction within the next consecutive period of 3 hours between the permitted hours of 9.30am and 4.00pm Monday to Saturday on any of the roads or lengths of road specified to which this restriction is applied. Before leaving a vehicle on any road or length of road to which this restriction applies the driver shall purchase and display in accordance with the conditions set out in section 9 of this Order a pay and display ticket from the machine provided for that purpose. All vehicles must be parked wholly within the parking bay marked on the carriageway. Failure to display a valid ticket or exceeding the maximum permitted stay shall render the driver liable to a penalty charge as set out in section 9 of this order. Whilst parked in the parking bay no person shall carry out any work relating to the construction or repair of the vehicle other than may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the parking bay. No person shall allow a vehicle waiting in a parking bay to be used for or in connection with the sale of any vehicle or any other article or for the offer of any service for reward. Provided that this restriction shall not apply to a vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge issued and displayed in accordance with the "Disabled Persons (Badges For Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000" and includes similar badges issued by other European Member States.

CHARGES FOR DESIGNATED PARKING PLACES

- 1d. With effect from 5th March 2007 and until such time as the Council may determine otherwise the initial charge to be paid before leaving a vehicle in a designated pay & display parking place, during the permitted hours, such parking place being identified in schedule 1 as being subject to a part 409 restriction is as follows

the initial charge for leaving a vehicle for a period not exceeding 1 hour shall be 20 pence

the initial charge for leaving a vehicle for a period not exceeding 2 hours shall be 40 pence

the initial charge for leaving a vehicle for a period not exceeding 3 hours shall be 80 pence

Part 207 from its junction with Stoughton Road to its junction with Francis Street, excluding the limited waiting parking boxes between 82 metres and 69 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street and 63 metres and 52 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street, and the layby between 36 metres and 3 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 the limited waiting parking box, from a point 82 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 69 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 the limited waiting parking box, from a point 63 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 52 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street

Part 409 the layby, from a point 36 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street to a point 3 metres south-east of its junction with Francis Street
