



**LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL
THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (MARKET STREET)
(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2008**

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester Traffic Regulation (Market Street) (Experimental) Order 2008 and shall come into operation on the 12th March 2008, and remain in force for a period of 18 months.
2. The existing prohibition of entry and driving restrictions, together with the existing waiting restrictions as specified in the Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2006 (Amendment) (Various Roads - Leicester City Centre-Part)(No.8) Order 2007 in relation to Market Street are hereby suspended and replaced by the restrictions as specified in the Schedule below for the duration of this Order.
3. This Order may be modified or suspended by the Director of Regeneration, Highways and Transportation, if it appears to him essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Act.
4. In relation to Section 3 of the Act, restrictions on traffic regulation orders, the Council are satisfied that for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the Order relates or any other road it is a requisite that subsection 3(1) of the Act shall not apply to the Order
5. It shall not be an offence or contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to enter or be driven on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a restriction applies in a manner contrary to that restriction provided that the person is acting upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or such other persons in uniform appointed for that purpose by the Chief Constable for Leicestershire.
6. It shall not be an offence or contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to enter or be driven on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a restriction applies in a manner contrary to that restriction if the vehicle is being used for Police, Fire & Rescue Service or Ambulance purposes.

7. It shall not be an offence or contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to enter or be driven on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a restriction applies in contravention of that restriction to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road or to enable work by any undertaker to be carried out relating to any pipe, cable, sewer or apparatus in or on that road.
8. It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait or to load and unload on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a waiting or loading restriction applies provided that the person is acting upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or such other persons in uniform appointed for that purpose by the Chief Constable for Leicestershire.
9. It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait or to load and unload on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a waiting or loading restriction applies if the vehicle is being used for Police, Fire & Rescue Service or Ambulance purposes.
10. It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a waiting or loading restriction applies for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from such vehicle.
11. It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a waiting or loading restriction applies for so long as may be necessary to enable postal packets to be loaded or unloaded from a postal vehicle.
12. It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a waiting or loading restriction applies in contravention of that restriction to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road or to enable work by any undertaker to be carried out relating to any pipe, cable, sewer or apparatus in or on that road.

13. It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road as specified in this Order to which a waiting restriction applies for up to 3 hours with return prohibited within a further consecutive period of 1 hour where the restriction is a prohibition of waiting and for any length of time where the restriction is a limit on the duration for which waiting is permitted provided that the vehicle is displaying a disabled persons blue badge in accordance with the rules appertaining to the issuing of such a badge or a disabled persons blue parking card issued in accordance with the rules of any member State of the European Community. Provided that no such vehicle shall wait where a prohibition of loading and unloading is in force, in a bus lane or in a loading only bay.

SCHEDULE

MARKET STREET (Its entire length)

Prohibition Of Entry And Driving, At All Times, All Motor Vehicles, (Except For permit holders at any time and except for loading or unloading on Saturday 5am – 9am, Sunday to Friday 5am – 10am)

No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at any time so as to enter, proceed or remain on any road or length of road to which this restriction is applied. Provided that this restriction shall not apply to permit holders at any time or to vehicles requiring to load or unload goods in the road or length of road specified or in any road or length of road only accessible via the road or length of road specified between 5.00am and 9.00am on Saturday also between 5.00am and 10.00am Sunday to Friday .

No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait at any time or to load or unload between midnight & 5am and between 9.00am & midnight on Saturday also between midnight & 5am and 10am & midnight Sunday to Friday on any of the roads or lengths of road specified to which this restriction is applied.
