

LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (EASTFIELD ROAD) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2008

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester Traffic Regulation (Eastfield Road) (Experimental) Order 2008 and shall come into operation on the 18th August 2008, and remain in force for a period of 18 months.
- 2. Upon Coming into force the existing waiting restrictions as specified in the Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2006 (Amendment) (Woodville Road Area)(No.30) Order 2008 in relation to the lengths of Eastfield Road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby suspended and replaced by the restrictions as specified in the Schedule below for the duration of this Order.
- 3. This Order may be modified or suspended by the Director of Regeneration, Highways and Transportation, if it appears to him essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Act.
- 4(i). No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait on sections of road listed in Schedule 1 of this Order between 8.00am and 9.00am or between 2.30pm and 4.00pm Monday to Friday. Provided that the restriction shall not apply in the circumstances listed below.
 - (ii) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order to which a waiting restriction applies provided that the person is acting upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or such other persons in uniform appointed for that purpose by the Chief Constable for Leicestershire.
 - (iii) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order if the vehicle is being used for Police, Fire & Rescue Service or Ambulance purposes.
- (iv) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from such vehicle.

- (v) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order for so long as may be necessary to enable postal packets to be loaded or unloaded from a postal vehicle.
- (vi) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order in contravention of that restriction to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road or to enable work by any undertaker to be carried out relating to any pipe, cable, sewer or apparatus in or on that road.
- (vii). It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order to which a waiting restriction applies for up to 3 hours with return prohibited within a further consecutive period of 1 hour provided that the vehicle is displaying a disabled persons blue badge in accordance with the rules appertaining to the issuing of such a badge or a disabled persons blue parking card issued in accordance with the rules of any member State of the European Community.
- 5(i) No Person shall stop or cause or permit a vehicle to stop or to wait or load or unload in any of the prohibited areas on any of the roads or lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday during School term time. For the purpose of this restriction a prohibited area is an area of road to which this restriction is applied which is marked in accordance with diagram 1027.1 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002. On any road or part of a road to which this restriction is applied and to which any other waiting restriction is applied this restriction shall prevail during the period 8.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday during School term time.
- (ii) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to stop on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order to which a clearway restriction applies in a manner contrary to that restriction provided that the person is acting upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or such other persons in uniform appointed for that purpose by the Chief Constable for Leicestershire.
- (iii) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to stop on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order to which a clearway restriction applies in a manner contrary to that restriction in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop, or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident, or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.
 - (iv) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to stop on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order to which a clearway restriction applies in a manner contrary to that restriction if the vehicle is being used to remove an obstruction from the carriageway.

(v) It shall not be a contravention to cause or permit a vehicle to stop on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order to which a clearway restriction applies in a manner contrary to that restriction if the vehicle is being used in the service of the Council in exercise of its statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used in such service it is necessary for the vehicle to be stopped at that place.

SCHEDULE 1

EASTFIELD ROAD

Prohibit a vehicle waiting Monday to Friday 8-9am and 2.30 – 4pm.

- a) east side from a point 43 metres north of its junction with Hinckley Road to a point 31 metres north of its junction with Hinckley Road
- b) west side from a point 5 metres north of its junction with Hinckley Road to a point 60 metres north of its junction with Hinckley Road

SCHEDULE 2

EASTFIELD ROAD

Prohibit a vehicle **stopping**, waiting or loading Monday to Friday 8am – 5pm during school term time

a) east side from a point 69 metres north of its junction with Hinckley Road to a point 43 metres north of its junction with Hinckley Road
