THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (COTTESMORE ROAD AREA) ORDER 2012

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester Traffic Regulation (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Cottesmore Road Area) Order 2012 and shall come into force on the 28th May 2012.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to exceed the speed of 20mph in the following roads:-

Barker Street – Its entire length
Beeby Road – Its entire length
Bridge Road – from its junction with
Uppingham Road to its junction with
Green Lane Road.
Cottesmore Road-Its entire length
Duxbury Road – Its entire length
Fernie Road – Its entire length
Harewood Street – Its entire length
Layton Road – Its entire length
Meynell Road – Its entire length
Mornington Street-Its entire length

Oakley Street- Its entire length
Parry Street- Its entire length
Percival Street -Its entire length
Quorn Road -Its entire length
Southdown Road -Its entire length
Spence Street -Its entire length
Stonebridge Street -Its entire length
Stroud Road- Its entire length
Sulgrave Road - Its entire length
Thurlby Road -Its entire length
Woodland Street -Its entire length
