THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (WILLOW BROOK ROAD AREA) ORDER 2012

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester Traffic Regulation (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Willow Brook Road Area) Order 2012 and shall come into force on the 28th May 2012.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to exceed the speed of 20mph in the following roads:-

Ash Street – Its entire length
Beech Street – Its entire length
Bushby Road-Its entire length
Farringdon Street –Its entire length
Frisby Road – Its entire length
Galby Street –Its entire length
Houghton Street –Its entire length
Larch Street –Its entire length

Lombardy Rise-Its entire length
Longcliffe Road- Its entire length
Oak Street- Its entire length
Pembroke Street -Its entire length
Prestwold Road -Its entire length
Quenby Street -Its entire length
Willow Brook Road -Its entire length
