THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (WESTERN ROAD AREA) ORDER 2012

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester Traffic Regulation (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Western Road Area) Order 2012 and shall come into force on the 28th May 2012.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to exceed the speed of 20mph in the following roads:-

Bisley Street – Its entire length
Briton Street – Its entire length
Bruce Street -Its entire length
Celt Street –Its entire length
Eastleigh Road – Its entire length
Equity Road –Its entire length
Gaul Street –Its entire length
Ivy Road –Its entire length
Noel Street – Its entire length
Norman Street-Its entire length

Paton Street- Its entire length
Roman Street- Its entire length
Ruding Road -Its entire length
Saxon Street -Its entire length
Sheffield Street -Its entire length
Stuart Street -Its entire length
Walton Street-Its entire length
West Street Open-Its entire length
Western Road- Its entire length
Wilberforce Road -Its entire length
