

THE LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (CONTA-FLOW CYCLE LANE) (THE GATEWAY) ORDER 2012

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order: -

- This Order may be cited as the Leicester Traffic Regulation (Contra-Flow Cycle Lane) (The Gateway) Order 2012 and shall come into force on the 13th August 2012
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait on the contra-flow cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order other than for the purposes of crossing it.

THE GATEWAY

1 Introduce an on-carriageway contra-flow cycle lane on the Gateway east side from the north side of its junction with Gosling Street to the north side of its junction with Deacon Street in that direction.
