

LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL THE LEICESTER TRAFFIC REGULATION (BARKBYTHORPE ROAD) (WIDTH RESTRICTION) ORDER 2013

Leicester City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Leicester Traffic Regulation (Width Restriction) Order 2013" and shall come into force on the 28th day of January 2013.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order,no person shall cause any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle exceeds 7 feet (2.1 metres) to proceed in that length of Barkbythorpe Road between 1 metre North-East and 1 metre South-West of the physical width restriction
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used as an emergency vehicle.
- 4. The Leicester Traffic Regulation (Amendment) (Barkby Thorpe Road)(Width Restriction)Order 1989 is hereby revoked.
