**THE LEICESTER (CONSOLIDATION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2006
(AMENDMENT) (CAREY'S CLOSE) (No.184) ORDER 2016**

Leicester City Council (the Council) in exercise of their powers under Section 1, 2, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (The Act) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-


1. This Order may be cited as The Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2006 (Amendment)) (Carey's Close) (No.184) Order 2016 and shall be included amongst the Orders which may be cited as The Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2006 and shall come into force on the 29th January 2016.
2.
 - (i) The expression "the Principal Order" means "the Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2006"
 - (ii) Any document referring to the Principal Order shall be construed as referring to the Principal Order as amended by this Order.
3. The Principal Order shall be amended as follows:
 - (i) In Schedule 1 to the Principal Order revoke existing Schedules relating to

Carey's Close
 - (ii) In Schedule 1 to the Principal Order insert Schedule 1 to this Order in the appropriate alphabetical order.
4. Nothing in this Order shall affect the Principal Order in its operation in relation to contraventions committed before the commencement of this Order

SCHEDULE 1

CAREY'S CLOSE

1. Introduce a Restricted Zone (No Waiting and No Loading at Any Time Except in marked bays) on the irregular shaped area known as Carey's Close bounded on its eastern side by Applegate, its southern side by the building known as City Block, its western side by the building known as City Block and Jubilee Square and its northern side by Jubilee Square and the property known as Wygston's House

North & East Side

2. Introduce Disabled Parking Bays within the restricted zone

South and West side

3. Introduce a Loading Only Bay between 7.30am to 6.00pm on the Western side of the restricted zone described above adjacent to the building known as City Block
