

LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER SECTION 16A OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (RTRA 1984) AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994

THE LEICESTER (CHARLES BENNION WALK PLAYING OUT) (ORDER) 2016

1. Leicester City Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over the following areas of the highway being:-

Prohibit the driving of all vehicles and prohibit waiting, loading or unloading at any time on Charles Bennion Walk between its junctions with Moccasin Avenue and Brogue Street between 1130 hours and 1430 hours on Tuesday 5th April 2016, Saturday 23rd April 2016 and Sunday 8th May 2016.

Diversion: None.

- 2. The Order is made to facilitate the Charles Bennion Walk playing out event.
- 3. The Order shall come into operation at 1130 hours on Tuesday 5th April 2016 and will remain in force until 1430 hours on Sunday 8th May 2016.
- 4. While the Order is in operation, traffic along the highway specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) as detailed in paragraph 1.
- 5. All restrictions will be signed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
- 6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
- Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
- Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto a section of highway to which the Order applies.
- 7. Any vehicles parked in contravention of a restriction contained in this order are at risk of being towed if the vehicle is not removed following a PCN being issued.
- 8. Access for residents and pedestrians will be maintained.
