

LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER** SECTION 16A OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (RTRA 1984) AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994

THE LEICESTER (CONTINENTAL MARKET APRIL) (ORDER) 2016

1. Leicester City Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over the following areas of the highway being:-

Prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at any time between 1700 hours and 2300 hours on Tuesday 19th April 2016 on the following sections of highway:

Gallowtree Gate: Between its junctions with Horsefair Street and East Gates. East Gates: Between its junctions with High Street and Gallowtree Gate.

Humberstone Gate: Between its junctions with Gallowtree Gate and Charles Street.

Prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at any time between 0900 hours and 1100 hours on Wednesday 20th April 2016, Thursday 21st April 2016, Friday 22nd April 2016, Saturday 23rd April 2016 and Sunday 24th April 2016 on the following sections of highway:

Gallowtree Gate: Between its junctions with Horsefair Street and East Gates. East Gates: Between its junctions with High Street and Gallowtree Gate.

Humberstone Gate: Between its junctions with Gallowtree Gate and Charles Street.

Revoke the prohibition of driving restriction between 1700 hours and 1900 hours on Tuesday 19th April 2016, Wednesday 20th April 2016, Thursday 21st April 2016, Friday 22nd April 2016, Saturday 23rd April 2016 and Sunday 24th April 2016 for continental market vehicles on the following sections of highway:

Gallowtree Gate: Between its junctions with Horsefair Street and East Gates. East Gates: Between its junctions with High Street and Gallowtree Gate. Humberstone Gate: Between its junctions with Gallowtree Gate and Charles Street.

A 6m emergency service access will be maintained at all times on the south-west side of Gallowtree Gate.

- The Order is made to facilitate the Continental Market event.
- The Order shall come into operation at 1700 hours on Tuesday 19th April 2016 and will remain in force until 1900 hours on Sunday 24th April 2016.
- 4. While the Order is in operation, traffic along the highway specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency access) as detailed in paragraph 1.
- 5. All restrictions will be signed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
- 6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
- Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
- Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto a section of highway to which the Order applies.

7. Any vehicles parked in contravention of a restriction contained in this order is at risk of being towed if the vehicle is not removed following a PCN being issued.
