BLABY DISTRICT COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 32 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "Blaby District Council (Enderby Road & Johns Court and Leicester Road Car Parks) (2 hours free parking) Experimental Order 2020 (Revocation) Order 2021 "and shall come into operation on 29 March 2021.

Interpretation

- 1 (1) In this Order -
the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order byelaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment

Revocation

WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Blaby District Council (Enderby Road & Johns Court and Leicester Road Car Parks) 2 hours free parking) Experimental Order 2020 is hereby revoked in their entirety.

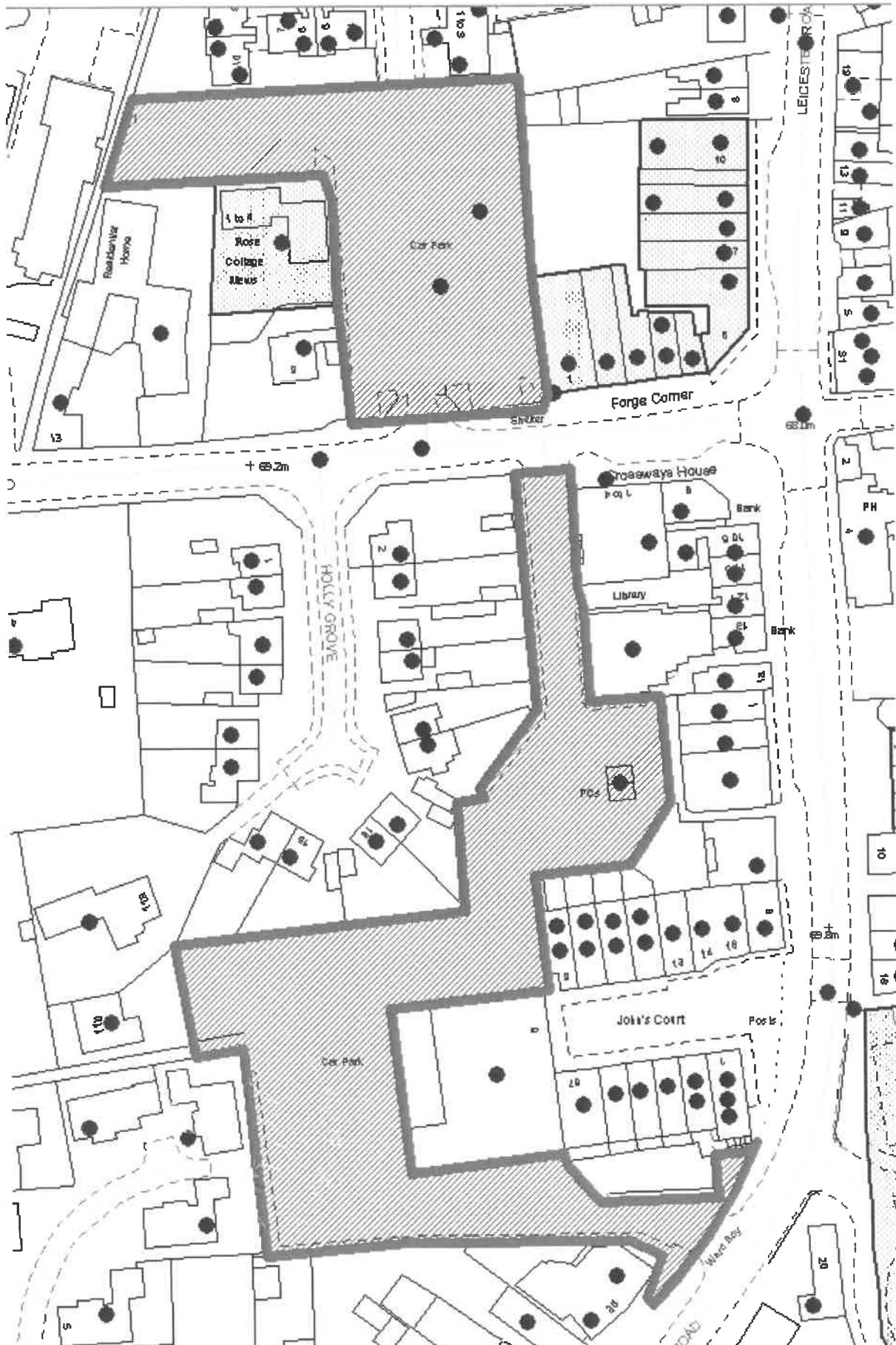

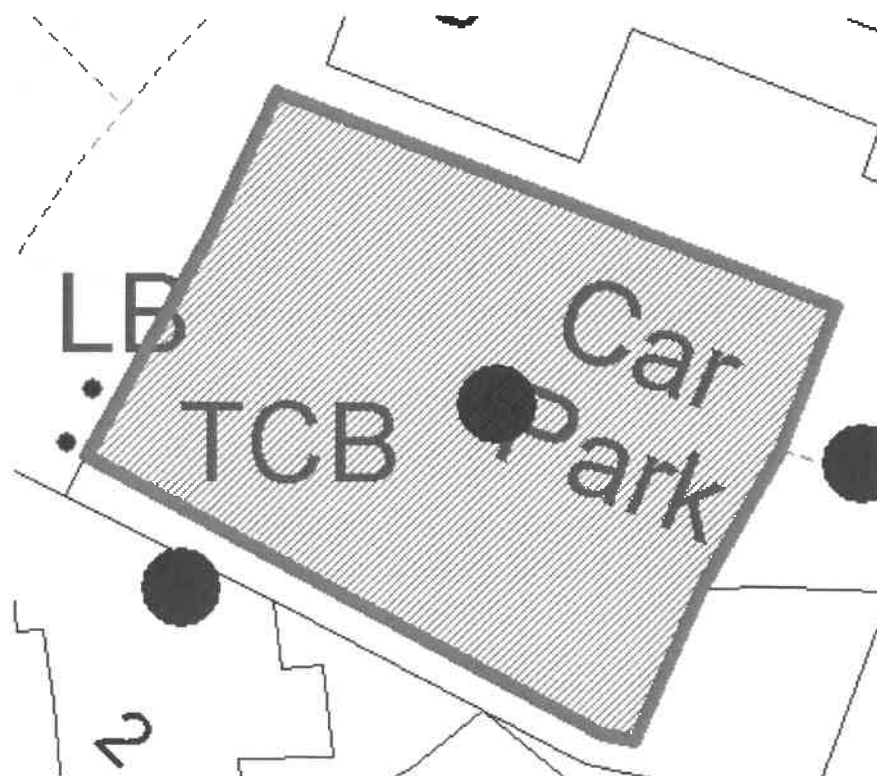
